As of 4/22/21, Hopkinton's Health Department is reporting 988 total confirmed COVID-19 cases; 37 of those cases are active, with 934 recoveries and 17 deaths. You can see historical tracking and updates on Hopkinton's Community Impact Dashboard which is updated frequently.

2021 Annual Town Meeting - REMINDER / NEW DETAILS

At the 3/23/2021 Select Board Meeting, the Hopkinton Select Board voted pursuant to M.G.L: chapter 39, section 10, to delay the Annual Town Meeting, currently scheduled to commence on May 3, 2021 at 7 PM, to commence instead on May 8, 2021 at 9:00 AM. Annual Town Meeting will be held outside, under a tent, at the High School Football Field, located behind the Hopkinton Middle School. Hopkinton Vaccine Metrics - NEW UPDATE

As of the most recent data available from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH), and the Massachusetts Immunization Information System (MIIS), dated 4/15/21, 69% of Hopkinton residents aged 20+ have had at least one dose of a Covid-19 vaccine.

Hopkinton Library Curbside Pickup Process Changing - NEW UPDATE

On Monday, April 26, the library will be moving to a new way to book curbside pickups. The reservation system will be integrated into your online catalog account and will allow you to book an appointment directly from the "Manage Your Account" library card portal. You will need the account access information for the library card that the holds are placed on. Please contact the library if you need your card number or PIN. <u>Appointment slots for next week will be unavailable over the weekend</u>, as we work to change over to the new system.

Regional Vaccine Clinic:

The Hopkinton Health Department is part of the Metrowest-Westborough regional collaborative and will be offering COVID-19 Vaccine appointments at the DoubleTree located at 5400 Computer Drive in Westborough, MA. The dates and times of the clinic will vary. You can check availability by monitoring this link. Appointments will be added on a rolling basis. You must be a Hopkinton resident and eligible to receive a vaccine in Massachusetts (any individual aged 16+ is eligible) to book an appointment using this link.



Massachusetts Covid-19 Vaccine:

As of Monday, April 19th, all individuals aged 16+ are eligible to receive a Covid-19 Vaccine in Massachusetts.

There are different ways to find a vaccine appointment:

- Preregister at <u>VaccineSignUp.mass.gov</u> to be notified when it's your turn to schedule an appointment at a mass vaccination or regional collaborative location
- Use <u>VaxFinder.mass.gov</u> to search for appointments at pharmacies, health care providers, and other community locations



Hopkinton Town Hall reopened to the public as of Monday August 10th. Appointments are required due to the state's COVID-19 limits on building occupancy: <u>click here for more information</u>. All town departments are open for business and many transactions can be completed online. We are available via phone and email to assist during regular business hours. A full Town Directory can be <u>found here</u>. A box at the front door of Town Hall may be used to drop off correspondence, applications, etc., and they may also be mailed or emailed.
