We are so excited to announce that our students will be returning to the NBMS campus!

Sixth grade PM Cohort will start on Monday, February 8th in the afternoon. Students may arrive by 12:45 with classes beginning at 1:05 and releasing at 4:00 PM. Students enter the building at their designated entrance and will be checked in by staff. Each student will be asked pertinent questions and receive hand sanitizer. They will report directly to their first period class where they will be provided lunch.

Sixth grade AM Cohort will start on Tuesday, February 9th. Students may arrive by 7:45 and after being checked in, report to their 1st period class. Breakfast will be served in the classroom. Class begins at 8:20 and students will be released at 11:15 AM.

Students enter and exit through the same entrance each day.

8TH GRADE FORECASTING
