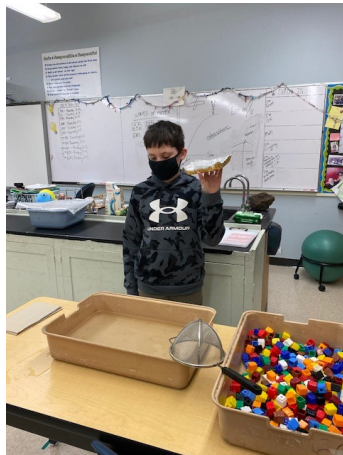
## TIN FOIL BOAT CHALLENGE

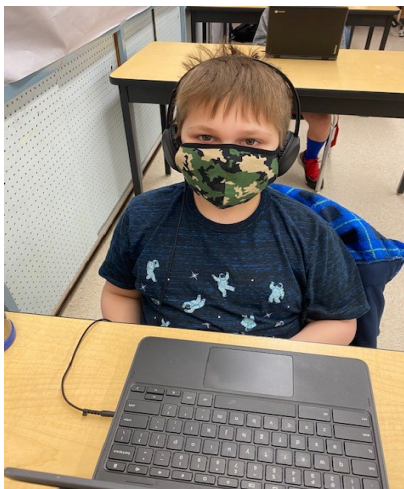
