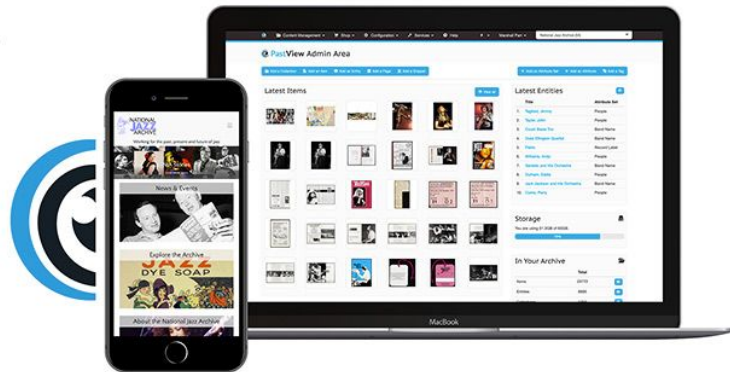

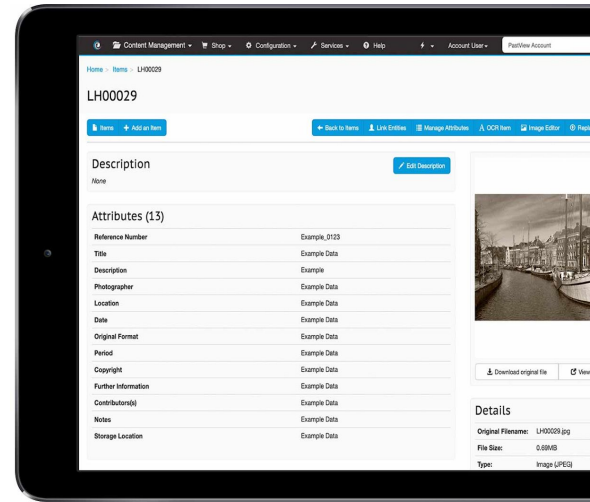

WHAT IS IT?

TownsWeb Archiving, developers of PastView, are bringing the PastView Lite package to support the cultural sector by offering a **12-months, completely free digital collections platform**, website, support and training package. There will be no upfront cost, ever and no recurring fees for the first 12-months.

Following the initial 12-months, the service can continue with a minimum payment of £69.99/month and £10.00/month per 10 Gb storage.

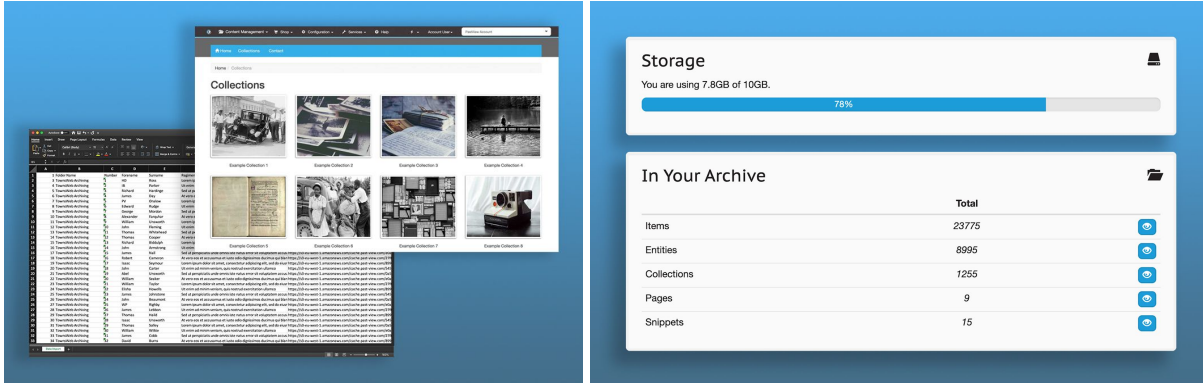

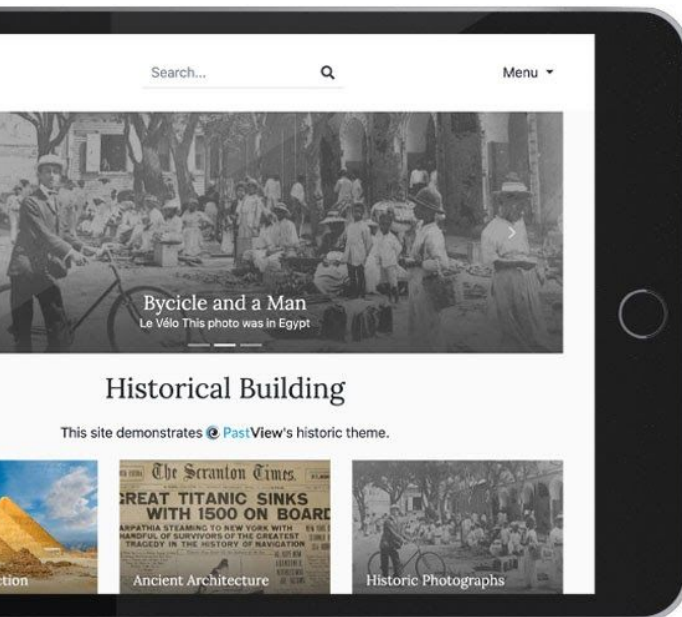

WEBSITE

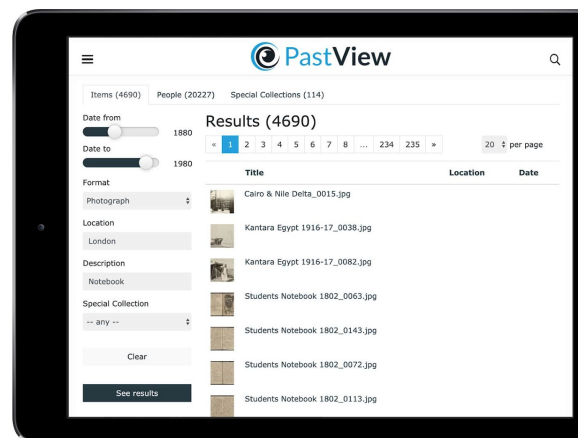
With a **pre-themed mobile-compliant website**, it's easy to get online. Flexibility to upload your logo, heading, colour scheme and page content. PastView Lite has everything you will need to take your digital collections online.

The website will incorporate an **'Image Search Engine'** and **'Browse the Archive'** making your website fully searchable by users to find your digital collections. Pre-defined attributes and attribute sets shall ensure you can add metadata to your images which form the basis of the search.

TRAINING

PastView Lite includes **two 30-minute remote training sessions** to provide a user with the confidence in navigating the platform and tools to set up the website ready for launch. Weekly training sessions are run in order to continue development and training, these 30-minute sessions are accessible to all PastView users. Online tutorials and help guides are available through the platform.

Consortium training will be provided collectively.



STORAGE

Your PastView Lite package **provides online storage for 10 Gb**, this will host around 5,000x images (each 2 Mb). Additional storage can be purchased at any time.
