OUSA Junior Nationals

April 1-3, 2022

East Fork State Park, Batavia, OH

The 24th annual edition of Orienteering Cinncinnati's Flying Pig orienteering event was held over the first weekend in April at East Fork State Park in southwestern Ohio. East Fork is one of the largest State Parks in Ohio and features some great spur & gully terrain on both sides of Lake Harsha, a large man-made reservoir.

For 2022 the Flying Pig played host to the 2022 Orienteering USA Junior Nationals competition with two days of classic distance orienteering with combined time scoring. Junior Nationals were contested on the Afton-Elklick (Sat) and Indian Mounds (Sun) maps. A middle distance NRE race on the Slabcamp Run map on Friday afternoon preceded the weekend activities.

Next year will be the 25th running of the Flying Pig and will feature the 2023 Orienteering USA Nationals, which were postponed from 2021 due to the pandemic. The events are scheduled to return to Carter Caves in Kentucky with a Sprint/Middle/Long format.







November 11-13, 2022 near Los Angeles, CA

The 2022 OUSA Nationals traveled west to the desert of southern California in November, kicking off with Sprint Distance races at Pierce College, an agricultural community college in the San Fernando Valley on a brand new map by Matei Sebo.

Saturday's Middle Distance races headed to the challenging Vasquez Rocks, a popular film location for westerns and sci-fi movies. No aliens were observed, but jackrabbits, road runners and a very fresh mountain lion track were observed near control #111.

The Long Distance races moved further out into the Mojave Desert to Red Rock Canyon State Park with it's colorful cliffs flanking the sides of a long N/S valley. High visibility and good runnability made for some fast times with subtle terrain features keeping folks focused on their navigation game.
