# TIPS AND TRICKS

### **CANVAS**

If you publish an item in an unpublished module, instructors and students might receive a notification about this item. However, while the instructor version will show the content, the student version will only tell them that the content is there but inaccessible to them.

### **KALTURA**

Canvas instructors can view analytics for their students and videos by going to Media Gallery >> Channel Actions icon (in the upper-right) >> Analytics. Then, at the bottom of the "Category Performance Over Time" chart, click the "View Details" link. Then you can select "Users" or "Entries," (ie, video entries) from the dropdown menu to view the analytics. **Note:** these may not be 100% accurate, so don't use these data for grading purposes. (Eg, browser ad-blockers will prevent Kaltura from collecting these data for that student.)

# **ZOOM**

<u>Update your Zoom!</u> **Poll access for alternative hosts**: If meeting hosts add alternative hosts to their meeting, they can allow alternative hosts to add or edit polls. The alternative host will have the additional in-meeting options to add or edit a poll, which launches the web portal to make the changes. Visit <u>the support article</u> for more information.
