NEW FEATURES

Read and Respond is a new feature in Canvas for Fall 2022 that allows instructors to create assignments using course Resource List materials. Instructors can 1) create assignments in which students add comments for a grade, 2) pose questions and provide feedback to students, 3) sync grades with the gradebook.
