**Gradescope is a grading application now available through Canvas as part of a Fall 2020 pilot**. A decision on the possible continued use of Gradescope will be completed at the end of the Fall 2020 semester. The tool supports fully online assignments, paper-based assignments, and programming assignments. <u>Get started with Gradescope</u>. The Gradescope team hosts general <u>weekly workshops</u> on Thursdays at 11am Central.

## TIPS AND TRICKS

#### CANVAS

To avoid students getting notifications when you upload sensitive files you want restricted (tests, answer keys, etc.), hide the Files Tool in Settings $\rightarrow$ Navigation, or upload the files into an Unpublished Folder.

#### ACCESSIBILITY

#### **KALTURA**

Kaltura Capture Annotation Tools can be used during screen capture. Kaltura Capture allows the user to annotate anything on the screen by drawing, inserting text, and more. Visit <u>The Recording Menu</u> to learn more about annotation tools.

Customizable Gallery View: Drag and drop participants into a specific order. Teachers can have students follow their view so everyone sees the same gallery order. Great for activities that require "going around the room".
