A Canvas quiz should not be open more than one tab at once. If a student begins a quiz in one tab, but finishes it in another (without closing the first) their answers will not save correctly. Please let your students know, especially for longer quizzes or those without time limits, that they need to be careful to have the quiz open in only one place at a time.
