TIPS AND TRICKS

CANVAS

Read and Respond is a feature in Canvas that allows instructors to create assignments using course Resource List materials. Instructors can 1) create assignments in which students add comments for a grade, 2) pose questions and provide feedback to students, 3) sync grades with the gradebook. ACCESSIBILITY

UDOIT Cloud is an educational tool for helping you improve your own accessibility design practices over time. The tool helps identify and fix accessibility issues across your entire Canvas course. It scans your course and produces a report of all accessibility issues, explanations, learning resources, and tools for reviewing and fixing issues. KALTURA

As mentioned last month, Kaltura is releasing Express Capture with a new "screen sharing" feature. Unfortunately, the screen sharing feature has not yet met our standards at for release, and we continue to work with Kaltura to drive improvements of the feature.
