TIPS AND TRICKS

CANVAS

The NEW **Collaborations tool** in Canvas will allow which allows users to create Google Docs, Google Spreadsheets, and Google Presentations. We want to turn this on so that you have more options in your courses going forward. Visit the Google Collaborations in Canvas blog post. to learn more.

IMPORTANT: When we turn on the new functionality, all old collaborations will be deleted from Canvas. If you have any Collaborations you would like to save from your courses (past or present), you will need to copy and paste that content to a new document in your own Rice google drive to save it. Your information needs to be saved by July 20th, 2022.

ACCESSIBILITY

<u>UDOIT Cloud is an educational tool</u> for helping you improve your own accessibility design practices over time. The tool helps identify and fix accessibility issues across your entire Canvas course. It scans your course and produces a report of all accessibility issues, explanations, learning resources, and tools for reviewing and fixing issues. KALTURA

Embed a video from the Media Gallery as part of the prompt for a Discussion board. This can be done while drafting the discussion instructions in the Rich Content Editor, and can serve as an engaging opener for a class discussion.

ZOOM

<u>Hosts and co-hosts are now able to Search breakout rooms</u> by name to better manage breakout rooms, allowing them to quickly view, assign, or move participants between breakout rooms.
