1. Covid-19 Guidelines:

2. Organizing Authority

Clearwater Community Sailing Center (CCSC) and 505 Fleet 15, St. Petersburg, FL.

3. Venue

Clearwater Community Sailing Center,1001 Gulf Boulevard Clearwater, Florida 33767. The racing area will be on the Gulf of Mexico, directly north-west of the Clearwater inlet.

4. Rules

This event is governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as changed by this notice of race, the sailing instructions, the prescriptions of US Sailing or the rules of the International 505 Class. The 505 Fleet 15 also reserves the right to change this notice of race.

5. Eligibility

The regatta is restricted to members of the International 505 Class.

6. Registration

- b. A late fee of \$25 applies after January 12th.
- c. Signed liability waivers must be received no later than 1200 hours, January 20th. Waivers can be executed online or at check-in.

7. Entry Fee

- a. Entry fee includes two days of racing and two evening meals for the competitors.
- b. Entry fee will be \$200 for each 505 class boat. The entry fee may be paid on the Club's secure site.

a. Prizes will be awarded to the drivers and crews placing first through third. The winning team will also be loaned the Midwinter Championship perpetual trophy. Their names will be etched on the trophy.
