SCHEDULING ORDER

26 FEBRUARY 2014

1. The following dates have already been established by the Commission for the next series of hearings:

- a. 14 - 18 April 2014
- b. 16 - 20 June 2014
- b. 11 - 15 August 2014

2. A Joint Defense Motion to Reschedule Hearings in April and June, 2014 (AE 263A) requested the Commission change the April dates to 7-11 April 2014. The Commission proposed changing the April session to either 14-17 April, 2014, or 28 April-1 May 2014, and permitted the parties to indicate their preferences.

3. Some defense teams had conflicts with the week of 28 April. At this time, the Commission is not confident he will be available the week of 7 April.

4. The Commission understands the defense position and will adjust the schedule to permit counsel to return on Friday, 18 April, rather than the original date of 19 April.

5. After considering the filings of all parties, and noting the conflicts indicated by counsel for Messer’s bin al Shibh and Hawsawi, the Joint Motion to Reschedule Hearings (AE 263A) is

DENIED.

6. The following dates are hereby set for the subsequent series of hearings:

a. **14 -17 April 2014**

b. 16 - 20 June 2014

b. 11-15 August 2014
