ALAMANCE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARIES

About the Program

The Home delivery service is for anyone eligible for a library card who is unable to get to the library due to injury, illness, lack of transportation/inability to drive, or who has difficulty carrying library materials.

A volunteer will deliver your bag of materials once a month and pick up the previous month's bag. You can check out up to 50 items at a time, and 20 of those can be DVDs.

Books, audio books and CDs are checked out to you for one year, and DVDs for 42 days. ACPL doesn't charge late fees, but may charge for lost materials.

If you are legally blind, you can also qualify for services through the North Carolina Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, and have audiobooks or books in Braille delivered to your home through the mail.

Selecting Materials

You can tell us specific items you want to receive, or you can let us pick for you. Most patrons do both and will request specific titles and take our selections as well. The application has a section for the types of books, movies, and CDs you like, your favorites authors, genres, etc., and your dislikes.

Materials available for delivery

- Regular print books
- Large print books
- Audio books on CD
- Playaways (put in an AAA battery and earphones, and you can listen to a book. No other equipment needed!)
- Movies on DVD and Blu Ray, including current, classic, foreign, documentaries, and recorded performances
- TV shows - current and classics
- Music CDs in many genres
- Magazines
