## The ACT Junior Chess League presents the 2020 PRIMARY SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIP – a fun chess day even for first timers!



Do you enjoy playing chess and representing your school? **The 2020 Primary Schools Championship is a fun chess tournament for all children currently attending primary school.** Playing conditions are the same as the primary school open or girls championships (that is, games are played with clocks with each player having 15 mins to complete his/her moves) and children compete as individuals. Even if you aren't part of a school team you can play in this event (and win trophies) on your own. The tournament may be used to determine the ACT representatives for the 2020 Australian Schools Team Championships (which is now an online event).

Awards are made to the first placed boy and first placed girl in each school year from kindy to year 6. There will also be team prizes based on the top 4 scorers for each school, which will determine the winning schools for the Open and Girls sections. This tournament caters to all standards of play. All children who can confidently make all the basic moves of chess are encouraged to participate and every participant receives a ribbon!

Tournament organisers reserve the right to add rounds if play seems likely to finish early. No players are "eliminated" during the day!
