ACTJCL 2020 Spring School Holiday Chess Frenzy - Boot Camp long time tournament is a two-day rated event for players born on or after 1 Jan 2000, played with long time controls (60 + 10s) on Wed 30th Sep & Thurs 1st Oct at Campbell High. *This is an excellent practice and warm up for any players participating in the upcoming ACT Junior Championship and the school team playoffs*.

Players are expected to record moves but if your child has never recorded moves before, or has never played long time control games of chess in a competitive environment, please let us know and we'll provide some instructions prior to the tournament. Please contact us to discuss the format if you are at all unsure.

When: Wed 30th & Thurs 1st Oct, 9am until 5pm daily.

Booking is for both days and Registration is from 8.45am

Where: Campbell High School Library, Treloar Crescent Campbell

Who: Children born on or after 1 January 2000

Cost: \$60 for both days – great value days of holiday fun!

Time Limits: Time limit will be 60 + 10 secs a move, so excellent practice and warm up for

players participating in the ACT Junior Championship and school team playoffs.

Awards: Prizes in events will include 1st & 2nd overall, with additional prizes awarded based

on the number of entries received. Every player receives a ribbon!

avoid missing out! Late entries will only be accepted if space allows.

Lunch: Pizza and drink (including juice and bottled water) is available for \$7 per child.

Snacks and drink are also available to purchase during the day.
