At the Spring Boot Camp – Chess Coaching and Lightning day, players will have a morning of top quality coaching from some of Canberra's best coaches. Coaching will take place in ability-based groups over 3 x 1 hour sessions. The afternoon is taken up by a fun event "Lightning". This event will help you prepare for the upcoming ACT Junior Championship. Please note we also have the Boot Camp Allegro on Tues 29th Sept and Boot Camp Long Time Tournament on Wed 30th Sept & Thurs 1st Oct (please see flyers attached). Discount of \$10 apply when you booked and paid in advance for all 4 days.

When: Monday 28th Sept 2020, 9am until 5pm. (Registration is from 8.45am)

Where: ACT Junior Chess Centre, Campbell High School Library, Treloar Cresent,

Who: Children born on or after 1 January 2000

Cost: \$50/day 9am-5pm per child (Coaching plus Lightning)

Time Limits: Lightning event is played with a 5min (blitz) time control. New players will learn how

to use clocks, and the rules of the event on the day.

Awards: Each coach will present a prize for outstanding effort on the day. Awards in the

Lightning event will include 1st & 2nd overall, with additional prizes awarded based

on the number of entries received and there will be lucky door prizes too!
