The ACT Junior Chess League will hold a simultaneous exhibition with Grandmaster **Anton Smirnov** for intermediate to advanced level ACT junior players. A simultaneous exhibition is an event where one player (typically of a master level) plays multiple games at the same time against opponents. This event presents a unique opportunity for ACT juniors to play one of Australia's highest rated grandmasters!

Eligibility Criteria:	<p>To be eligible, juniors must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have been born on or after 1 January 2003, and • Reside in the ACT or immediate surrounds, and • Have an Australian Chess Federation standard rating of 500 or greater, and • Be able to demonstrate a regular chess commitment (i.e. school chess club, Norths Junior Chess Club, Canberra, Tuggeranong or Gungahlin Chess Clubs, Street Chess etc) over a period of several months at a minimum, or have played in at least three ACTJCL and/or ACTCA events in 2021. • Have a history of displaying good sportsmanship and good behaviour at ACTJCL events.

How to Apply:	Please do not apply if your child does not meet the eligibility criteria (see above). Apply to Kate Woodley – kwoodley@outlook.com by 5pm Monday 3rd May , including your child's name, date of birth, school attended and a phone number where a parent can be contacted on the day. I will advise you if your child has been successful by Wednesday 5 th May. Limit of 19 players. If we receive more than 19 applications, preference will be given to players who meet the eligibility criteria and who have entered the 2021 ACT Championship (entries to open shortly). After that, applicants will be ranked by standard ratings.
Lunch:	Players need to bring their own lunch and snacks as no food will be sold at the venue.
Notes:	Parents, please provide details to the organiser of any medical or custodial issues for your child. This should include any known allergies, chronic medical conditions and behavioural issues that may have an impact on your child's participation in, and enjoyment of our activities.
