

Street Outreach & Response Team (SORT)

Street Outreach Response Team (SORT) is responsible for engaging with individuals and families experiencing homelessness who are on the street or camping (meaning both tent camping and car/RV camping) to provide proactive resources and service connections. SORT is a collaborative effort among interested agencies coordinated by a staff person and fueled by SORT volunteer team members who meet weekly or bi-weekly to discuss and share efforts.

Contacts

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What to expect as a volunteer?

- Meet at the back entrance of the CDDC Friday mornings around 8:45am. Street outreach is generally from 9-11am.
- Upon arrival, your temperature will be taken (COVID protocol). Team members will take turns loading their packs with supplies.
- If you can, bring a backpack or bag you are comfortable carrying up to 10-20 pounds of supplies. Bags are also available to borrow.
- You will join an outreach team with a team lead. You will never go out alone.
- Please let us know if you have mobility or other access needs. We can adapt and support!
- Bi-weekly SORT meetings Tuesdays 11am-12pm via Zoom. Email invitation sent out in advance. These are optional, please feel free to join.
