Arrest Made in an Unarmed Carjacking Offense: 4000 Block of Ames Street, Northeast

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department's Carjacking Task Force announce an arrest has been made and additional suspects are sought in reference to an Unarmed Carjacking offense that occurred on Monday, November 15, 2021, in the 4000 block of Ames Street, Northeast.

At approximately 2:47 pm, the suspect approached the victim at the listed location. The suspect assaulted the victim and took the victim's property. The suspect then fled the scene in the victim's vehicle.

On Wednesday, January 19, 2022, pursuant to a DC Superior Court custody order, a 17 year-old juvenile male, was arrested and charged with **Unarmed Carjacking**.

This case remains under investigation.
