Suspect Sought in Armed Robbery (Knife) Offenses in the First District

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department’s Carjacking Task Force seek the public’s assistance in identifying and locating a suspect in reference to Armed Robbery (Knife) offenses that occurred on Saturday, November 12, 2022, in the First District.

In each of the below offenses, the suspect approached the victim at the listed location, brandished a knife, took the victim’s property, and fled the scene.

- At approximately 6:56 pm, in the 1600 block of East Capitol Street, Southeast. CCN 22-165-288
- At approximately 7:35 pm in the 100 block of 16th Street, Southeast. CCN:22-165-938
- At approximately 7:25 pm, in the 1500 block of Independence Avenue, Southeast. CCN: 22-165-937
