The City of Portland is launching a Sustainable Neighborhoods Program! We are inviting all Portland neighborhoods and island communities to apply and will select two of them to help us launch the program this year.

Participating Sustainable Neighborhoods will identify areas they want to work on within their community. They can then earn credits by completing projects, hosting workshops, or organizing events. Neighborhoods will earn credits and receive certification as a "Participating Sustainable Neighborhood" or as an "Outstanding Sustainable Neighborhood" as well as recognition from the City.
