- Class Series 2: Civil Only Cases To be held in the King County District Court Burien courthouse

To be considered for the pro tem class, you must be an active member in good standing with the Washington State Bar Association and have a minimum of five years of civil or criminal experience as a practicing attorney. King County District Court encourages applicants of diverse backgrounds.
