1. Introduction

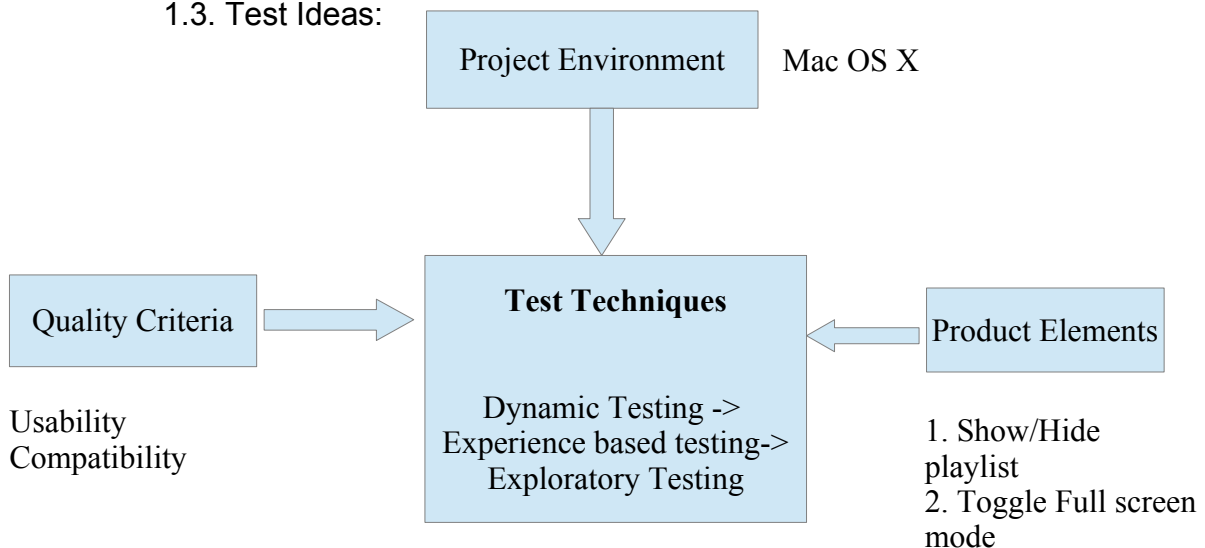
1.1. Overview

The test scope will be limited to two specific components such as ‘*Show/Hide Playlist*’ and ‘*Toggle Full screen Mode*’.

1.4. Sources of Test Ideas:

1.4.1. Product:

- Capability: Check show/hide playlist & toggle full screen functionality for different types of files.
- Data: Collect different codecs (file format).
- Product History: VLC media player (Version 2.0.9 Two flower (Intel 32bit)).
- Competitors: Windows Media Player, MX Player, Quicktime Player.

2. Testing Methodologies Used

2.1 Black-box Testing

Black box testing validates the functionality of the application without any knowledge about the internal implementation.

2.2.1 Functional Testing

2.2.1.1 Component Interface Testing

Component Interface Testing is performed between *Show/Hide Playlist* and *Toggle Full screen Mode*.

2.2.2 Non-Functional Testing

2.2.2.1 Usability Testing

Usability Testing is performed for all the options present in the *playlist* component.

3. Test Execution

Pre-Conditions:

1. Install the VLC media player (Version 2.0.9 Two flower (Intel 32bit)) in the Machine.
2. Operating System used: Mac OS.
3. Video files with any of the file format should be present in the system.

4. Issue Description

Summary: Black Screen is displayed by tapping on ‘*Toggle Full screen Mode*’ button from playlist screen

Pre-requisite:

1. VLC media player (Version 2.0.9 Two flower (Intel 32bit)) should be installed in the Mac OS (10.9.2). 2. Video files should be present in the system.

Steps to Reproduce:

Step 1: Launch the VLC media player.

Step 2: Click on *File* option. Select any one/more Video files by clicking on *Open file* option. Click on “*Open*” button.

Step 3: Click on “*Show Playlist*” button while the video is playing

Step 4: Click on “*Toggle Full Screen mode*” button while the window is in Playlist page.

Expected Result:

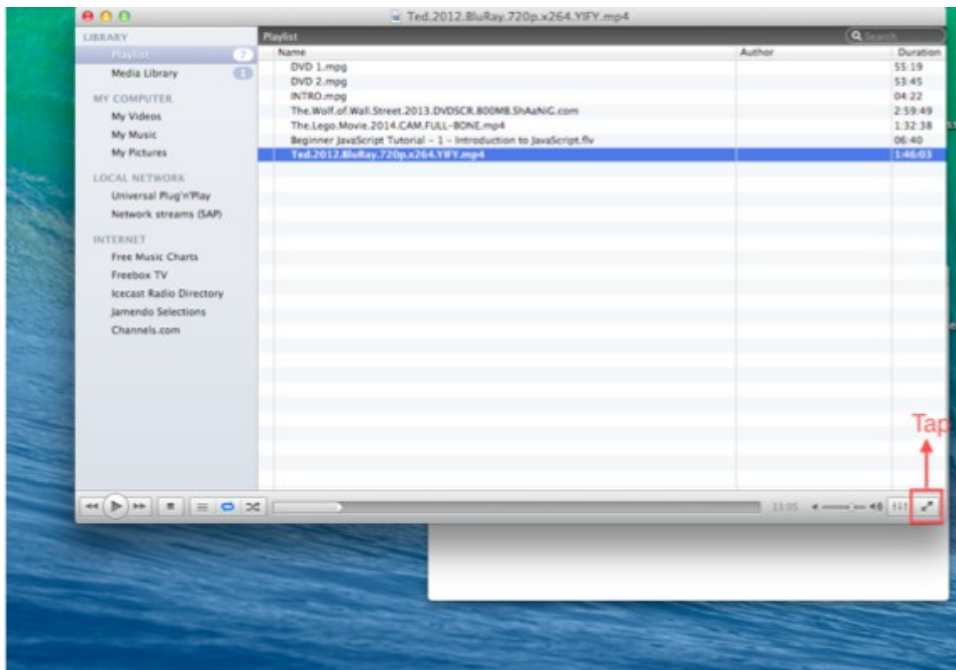
The selected video should be played in Full Screen.

Actual Result:

Black Screen is displayed in Full Screen instead of the video.
