

#### – future development + redevelopment

- ordinance + regulations
- building codes + design guidelines
- existing development
  - CIP projects
  - buyouts, elevations, demo-rebuild

# CHAPTER 19

reduces the risk of flood loss in Houston

# **CURRENT CODE**

- applies to property in the 100 year floodplain
- only protects 1 foot above 100 year flood elevation

# PROPOSAL

- applies to property in the 500 year floodplain
- protects X feet above 500 year flood elevation
- no net fill in 500 year floodplain







Current Regulations Protected to 1 FT. Above 100 Year

Current Regulations Protected to 1 FT. Above 100 Year




Current Regulations Protected to 1 FT. Above 100 Year Proposed Regulations Protected to X FT. Above 500 Year

#### Impacted Area + Acreage

100 year = 117,240 Acres

500 year = 33,615 Acres

ELEVATION	500 year + X feet	100 year + 0 - 1.5 feet	500 year + 0 feet
