

Joseph M. Smith Community Service Lifetime Achievement Award

Joseph M Smith was a longtime community leader/organizer in Allston Brighton and was instrumental in developing many of the community service organizations in existence today including the Allston Civic Association.

Candidates must be a present or former resident of Allston Brighton or work or have worked in Allston Brighton.

The award will be presented at the Allston Civic Association June meeting.
