Transportation/Parking

Getting to and from the festival:

- Public transportation is the best option as there will be minimal parking available!
- Minimal parking will be available for pre-purchase in Harvard Square via Pro Parks.
- The only on-site parking will be for staff, crew and Platinum ticket holders.
- There will be Traffic & Parking Officers in both Boston & Cambridge monitoring residential roads.
- The MBTA is increasing Red Line frequency and there will be extra buses added to the rout #66 and #86 buses for all 3 evenings, 6PM – 2AM
- There will also be 3 buses standing by on Western Avenue at North Harvard Street at 10:30PM. These buses will be heading toward Dudley Station.
- Both routes will be on diversion due to North Harvard Street & JFK Street being closed at the end of the evening. More specific info on route diversions may be found at <http://www.mbta.com/schedules>
- There will be a dedicated ride share lot at 114 N. Harvard St. in Allston & at the Cambridge Common in Cambridge, both of which will be directed by the Boston & Cambridge Police Departments.
- Beginning at 9PM until approximately midnight, North Harvard Street, in Allston along with JFK Street, in Cambridge will be closed to allow for maximum attendee departure and pedestrian safety.

Key Pre & Post Festival Logistics

- The majority of work will occur on weekdays, during daytime hours. There will be some overnight work taking place during the festival weekend as artists arrive and unload their equipment.
- All trucks coming to work at the event during the week of the build will be directed to exit off the Mass Pike onto Soldier's Field Surface Road to avoid impacting the residential community.
- The Festival's first sound check will be Wednesday, May 23 from 4:30-6PM.
- Breakdown takes about 3 days to complete, and the festival site and surrounding areas will be returned to the condition it was in before the festival.
- **There will be ample MA State Police, Boston Police & Cambridge Police Officials directing festival attendees to and from the site.**
