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Chapter: 1 Root Causes for T-Agitation.

Let's explore the root cause for T-Agitation, prior to 1956 AP was part and parcel of Tamilnadu state, Telugu people have bared lot of insults and got exploited in the hands of tamilians. Even now we are experiencing tamilians torture in the form of Chidambaram who announced separate state for Telangana. Telugu people who realized that they are being exploited by tamilians, started movement to form separate state for the Telugu speaking people. Finally AP was formed on November 1, 1956. Chapter 2

Factors exaggerated T-Agitation.

- Media that to especially TV9 was involved in very breaking of T-Agitation into big scale.
- Uncensored conversation of KCR and their party member
- No immediate solution with Central Govt
- Pro-Telangana MSO has strongly condemned the feeling of Telangana people.
- Other small state demand also provoked importance of Telangana state formation.

- Lack of enough finance in the state due to schemes implemented by State Govt.
- Financially again Hyderabad assets resembled Nizams development rather than previous govt contribution.
- Debates organized by the Media were conducted with political people rather than with well knowledge persons.
- 80 percent of people of state secretariat are from Seemandhra.
- In order to provoke disturbance between two regions politician murdered some of the telangana student.
- Tank Bund Issue.
- Student arrests.
- Lack of opportunities to Osmania students soon after initially agitation.
- No unity among state congress members from various regions.
- Censoring maximum coverage on telangana related issues in both Print & Media.
- Establishment of Regional provocative channels Eg: Raj News, T- News
- AP Union Public Service Commission committed fraud by selecting less number of Telangana candidates for key posts.
- Lack of employment in telangana region.
- Support from Telangana MSO.

Since from last year, some media channels in AP are saying government curb on media channels about the movement and incidents in OU. After silence in OU, it is turn for pro Telangana media channels for provoking cable operators and MSO's in Telangana region. They also urged the same to government and threatened to block pro Andhra news channels in their locations.

As TRS is saying that the media is in the hands of Andhra people. Interestingly, TRS has own news channel with KTR (son of KCR) as CEO. His media make him hero with coverage to every statement and incident in last one year and so called Andhra media is also focusing on the Telangana issue because they will lose the popularity in the T-region.

The media has played an important role in agitating the Telangana movement by playing the controversial videos of politicians (Andhra & Telangana). The media also went for debate on these topics which never end with a conclusion.

Chapter 3: Pro's and Con's of various action recommended by official.

Solution 1: Separate State for Telangana making Hyderabad as separate territory.

Pro: KCR who motivated and provoked people of telangana will be partially get satisfied and Andhra & Rayalaseema region people will be happy to some extent as Hyderabad which was majorly developed by the Seemandhra people feel was kept aside by not clubbed with telangana state. Solution-3: Declaring Hyderabad as Second capital rather than splitting the state into three or four parts.

Con: Completely state people will be dominated by outsider's end of the day north Indian will clinch job of local people that even worse the condition compared to now.

Solution -4: Declaring Presidential rule in the State.

Pro: Many factors that provoked the agitation will gets settled from time being but surface as soon as government is formed.

Con: Agitation will resurface again as very cause of agitation is not answered by implementing presidential rule.

Solution -5: Making Jagan as CM

Pro: He got enough capability to crub the telangana issue for his own political benefit.

Con: If yet all jagan is murdered, the complete scene will be repeated.

None of the above solutions can resolve the actual problem. This report suggest new reform which need to be implemented to solve the problem.

"EPR" stands for Economical Presidential Rule.

- -It is not purely presidential rule with Article 356 getting amended.
- -EPR ignores Article 356 and gives some preliminary powers to local elected leaders.
- -Local MLA and MP's will exist but they will not involve in ruling their constituencies.
- -MLA and MP's are restricted only to monitor constituencies by reporting problems to government officials.
- -Special officials recruited by the Central Government will monitor the socio economic development.
- -Chief Minister will not exist during EPR.
- -Supreme Powers rest in the hands of Central Government i.e. President.
- -Special package will be given in order to settle financial disputes between various regions through implementing various social economic projects.
- -Once financial position of all the region come to same stage EPR will be removed and again State government with Council of Ministers will be restored.
- -Special Ordinance will be introduced only by majority of local people acceptance.
- -Prime Minister will lead the state as main representative behalf of president.
- -All Financial grants will be provided by central government in name of president.
- -Limitation to be laid on Media channels over covering political disputes within their parties.
- -Circular on development took place will be displayed periodically behalf of president chamber.
- -People in their once locality will asked what all different sort of step need to be taken for Development.

Chapter -5 Feature of ECGR

"ECGR" stands for Economical Central Government Rule.

-It is not Presidential rule at all.

-Few clauses and restriction that are implemented during presidential rule will be implemented.

-Local MLA and MP's will exist but they will not involve in ruling their constituencies.

-MLA and MP's are restricted only to monitor constituencies by reporting problems to government officials.

-Special officials recruited by the Central Government will monitor the socio economic development.

-Chief Minister will not exist during ECGR.

-Supreme Powers rest in the hands of Central Government i.e. Prime Minister.

-MP's will have more weightage compared to MLA's.

-Special package will be given in order to settle financial disputes between various regions through implementing various social economic projects under schemes of Prime Minister.

-Once financial position of all the region come to same stage ECGR will be removed and again State government with Council of Ministers will be restored.

-Special Ordinance will be introduced only by majority of local people acceptance.

-President will lead the state as main representative behalf of Prime Minister.

-All Financial grants will be provided by central government in name of Prime Minister.

Special Chapter: EUNR

"EUNR" stands for Economical United Nations Rule, that means America and other countries will rule the AP state in order to bring social-economic equality. Neither President nor Prime Minister Rule the state: Outsourcing the development task to either British or America

Chapter 6: Additional Measure which are needed to be taken.

- 1. Delisting of regional parties in any state in order to save integrity of state. Eg: TRS party.
- 2.Government must very be very vigilant over Media like Raj News, TV9
- 3.Immediate change of MLA or MP to be taken in case separate state demand rises.
- 4. New constitutional amendment need to be made in order to fight separatist demands.
- 5. Patriotic laws are to prepared to every state in order to crub special demands in respective States.
- 6. President must declare the assets of all regions time to time.
- 7. Special Assessments need to be made by central government over state government's economic progress and it has to convey to the local people by central government only in the form of White Paper.
- 8.Leaders must never discuss political disputes within the party with media channels, one need to stop political drama.
- 9. Strong civilian society need to form at all regional level that monitors development and they Can ask political leader if so they are not working.
- 10. Economical report of the region must be declared by the president time to time , that will Make regional people to understand where they stand.
- 11. Number of political party in a state need to restrict to 3 or 4 only.
- 12. Recall of politician must be familiarzed among the citizens.

Chapter -7 Settling Hyderabad Dispute.

Declaring Hyderabad as free zone will not solve the problem

Solution 1: Might be declaring Hyderabad as 7th Zone will solve the problem to some extent but it require some special attention from administrative people in order to assess its Pro's and Con's.

Solution 2: All the job need to be filled as per ratio of population from each region.

Solution 3:From each zone extra people will be selected and they need to be getting posted in Hyderabad region. Share of people born in Hyderabad need to be restricted to 20 percent only.

Solution 4: Reducing the circle of Hyderabad region from 90kms radius to 10kms radius will solve the problem. Too much of urbanization will cause problem. Surrounding area of Hyderabad need to be mixed with adjacent zones so that people born in surrounding areas will get jobs in their respective zones itself.
