****Velz was known as a city full of talmidav chachomim and readily followed the recommendation of the Mishnah Brurah(551:90) not to fast on each of the days of the three weeks. As a gesture of friendship to all the surrounding shtaytelech no so wisely endowed, and to spare them from having to fast every one of those days, the Velzer Rebbe had more than a dozen chassidim travel every morning (until close to Tisha B'ov) to the surrounding Shtaytelech and make a siyum after shachris. This enabled the people in those shtaytelech to have bagels and cold cuts for breakfast every day. The Rebbe called it a siyum Gemach and noted that this helps people prepare for the major fast when we cannot eat here below but Hashem conducts a Tish Above."- Rabbi Mel Teitelbaum**
