

Bedford Town Trail Walk

Hartwell Town Forest

Please join the Bedford Trails Committee for a free trail walk in the woods! We plan to explore the Hartwell Town Forest. Pace will be leisurely.

February weather! The walk will go on regardless of weather! Prepare for cold, wind, and snow, with appropriate footwear and waterproof layers. Ski poles, snowshoes, and/or ice creepers may be necessary.

The Hartwell Town Forest is a lovely place to walk in the summer, but tends towards wet. That should not be a problem on this walk. Depending on how the weather goes in the week following the blizzard, snowshoes and/or ice creepers may be necessary. We will attempt to traverse from the entrance on Hartwell Road over to Fam Camp and back.

Difficulty Level: Moderate. The walk is less than 2 miles round trip and will take about 1 to 2 hours.

When and where: Leave from the parking lot behind the Bedford Free Public Library at 10:00 a.m.

Arrive early to sign up for the walk! We'll head over to the Hartwell Town Forest trailhead on Hartwell Road, close to South Road..

Note: All walks are at your own risk. Depending on the time of the year, ticks may be out, and poison ivy may be active. Please wear comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes or boots that can handle wet or mud, and ice and snow in the winter. Dogs on a leash and children are welcome.
