

Bedford Town Trail Walk

Old Reservoir / Valente Land

Please join the Bedford Trails Committee for a free trail walk in the woods! We plan to explore the Old Reservoir / Valente Land area. Pace will be leisurely.



January weather: the walk will go on even in the cold or moderate snow! Prepare for cold, wind, and snow with appropriate footwear and waterproof layers.

Known as "The Old Rez," the Old Reservoir land is one of the Town's most interesting and popular municipal open space areas. One of the significant features of the terrain is its changing grade. Steep inclines and declines provide for more strenuous hiking and biking than typically found on other trails within the Bedford trail network.

Difficulty Level: Moderate. The walk is about 2 miles and takes about 1 – 1.5 hours.

When and where: Leave from the parking lot behind the Bedford Free Public Library at 10:00 a.m.

Arrive early to sign up for the walk! We'll head over to the Old Reservoir trailhead.

Note: All walks are at your own risk. Depending on the time of the year, ticks may be out, and poison ivy may be active. Please wear comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes or boots that can handle wet or mud, and ice and snow in the winter. Children and dogs on a leash are welcome.
