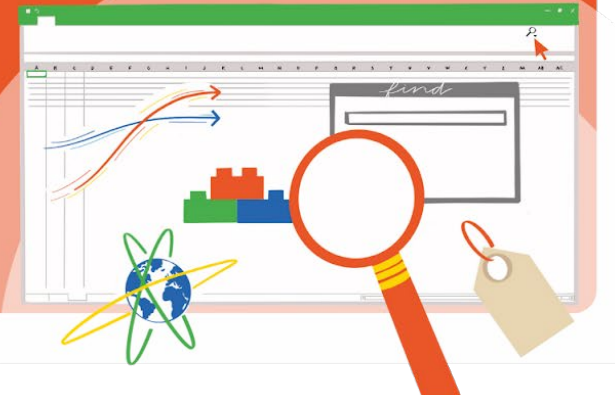
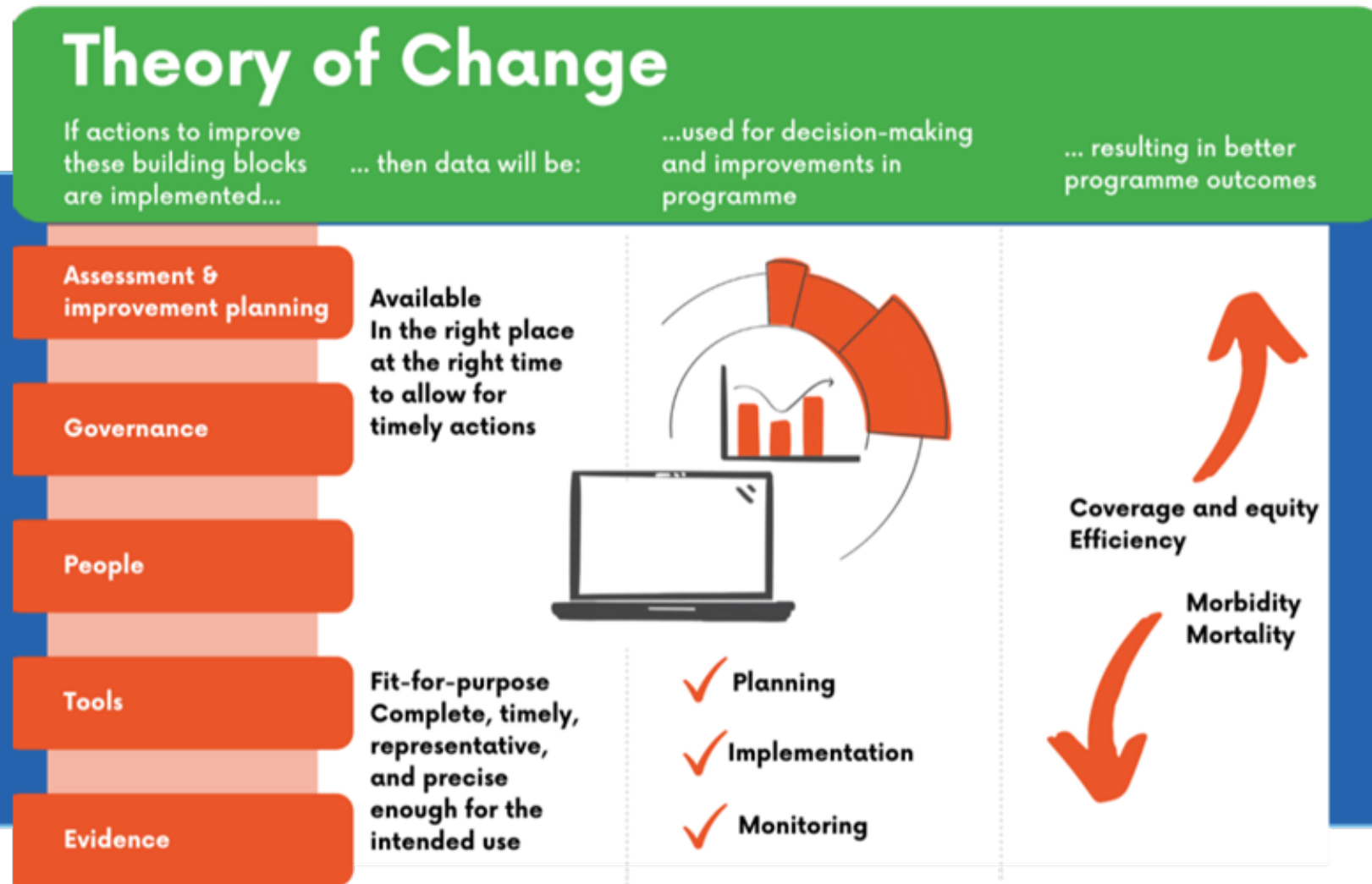


FIGURE 4. Data Theory of Change

Data systems will be transformed or strengthened and expanded in order to deliver on the IA2030 Impact Goals





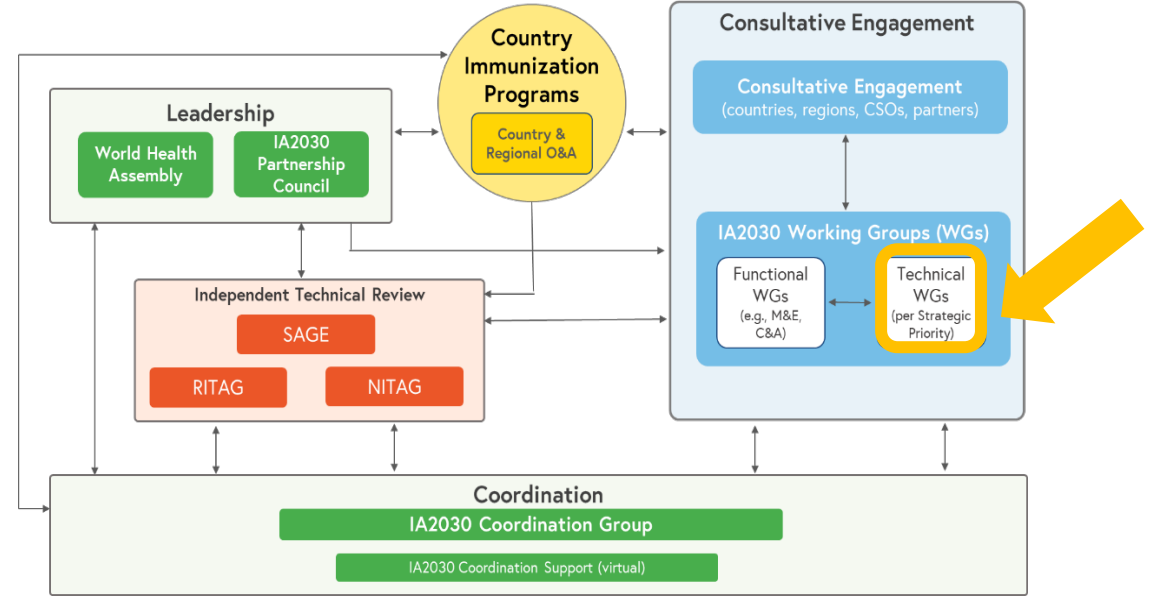
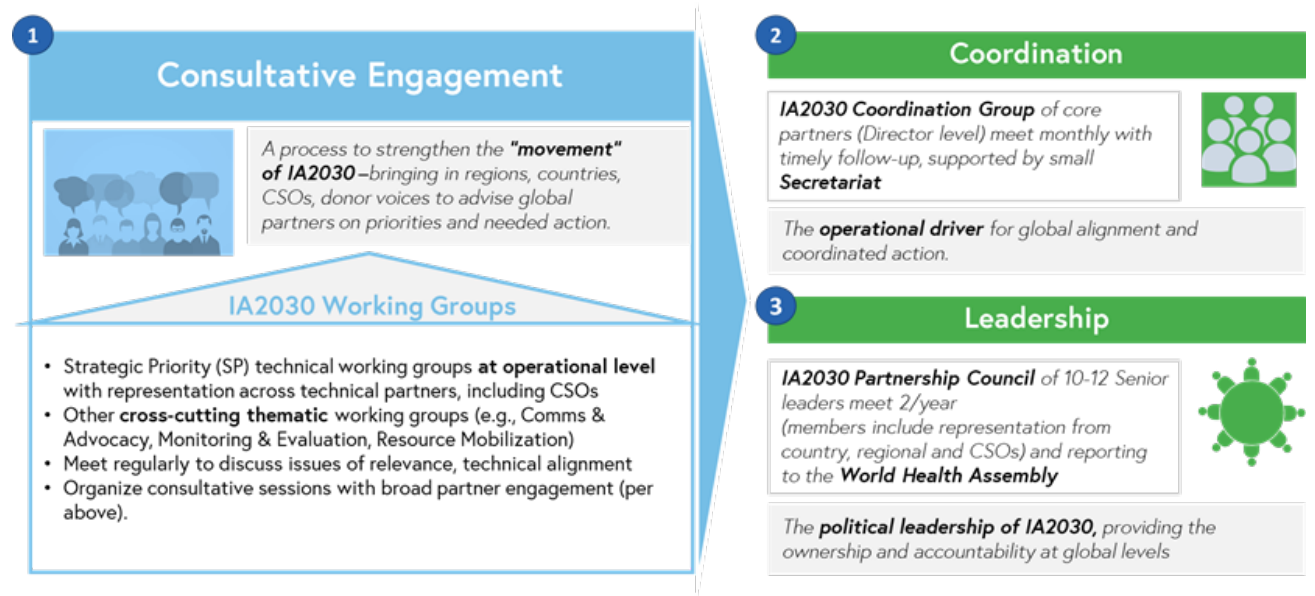

Orientation to the IA2030 Secretariat Structure



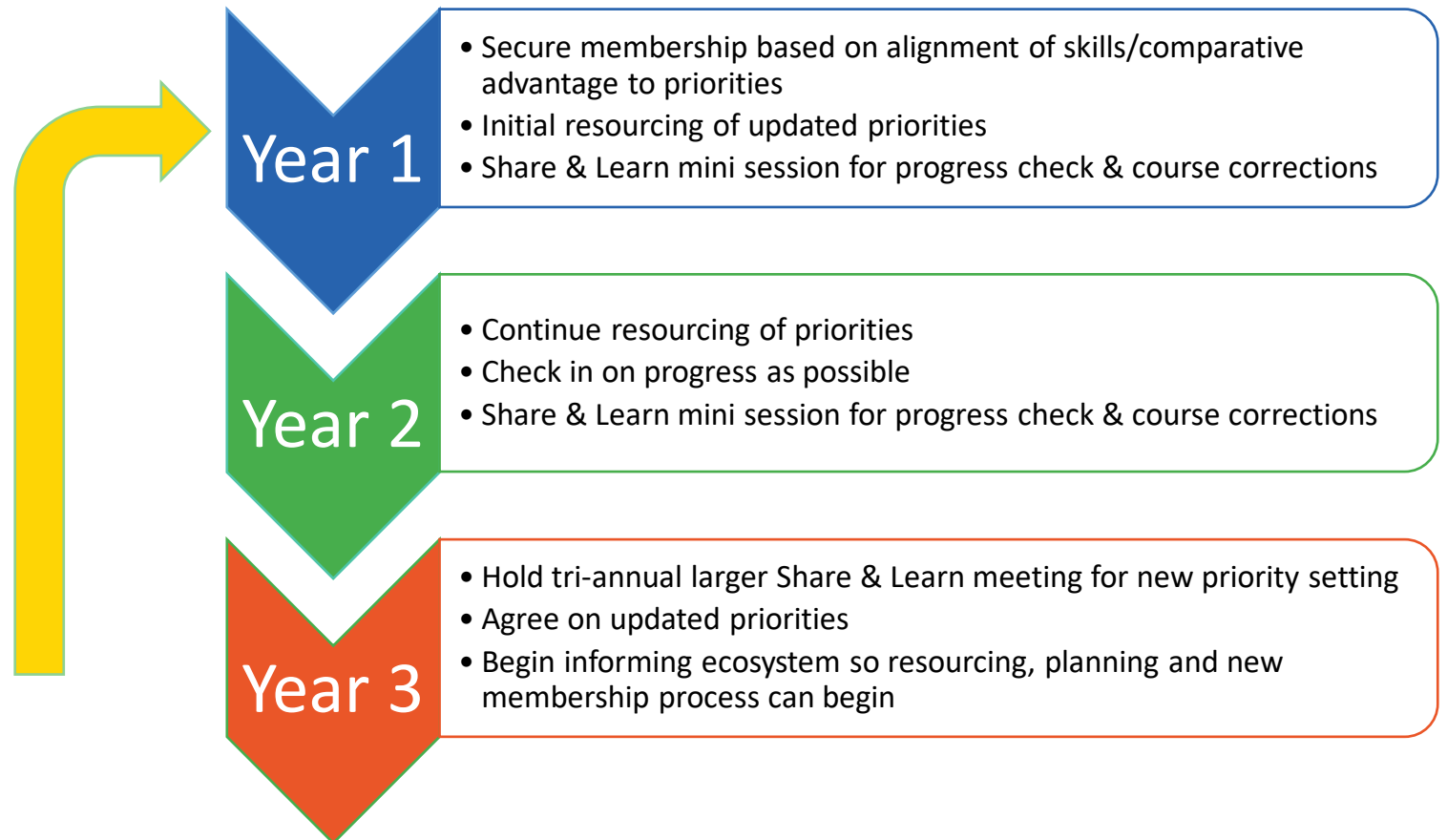


Basic Working Group Functioning

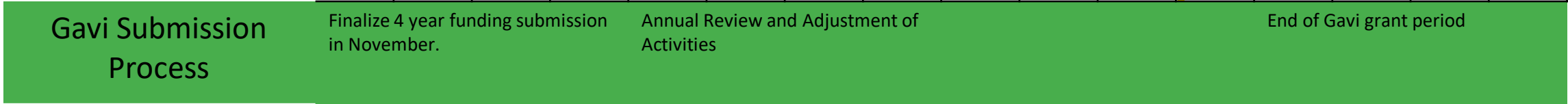
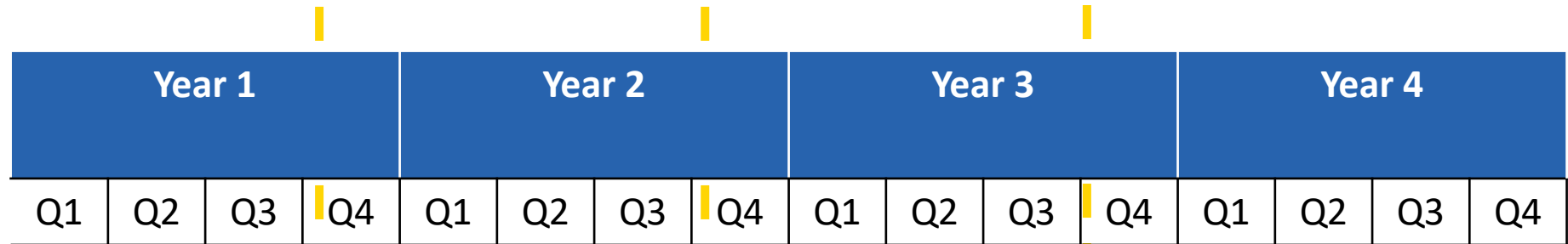
3-year priority setting and membership cycle in alignment with Secretariat 3-year cycle

Priorities for each cycle are set by an open “Share and Learn” meeting that would convene to:

- ✓ Allow partners to present what they’ve learned in the past 3-year cycle
 - ✓ Propose next 3-year priorities
 - ✓ Set timelines and milestones for the next 3-year priority agenda
- **Membership for the next 3-year cycle** would be based on the agreed upon general criteria and be calibrated for bringing on members who have skillsets that can help advance the next 3-year cycle priorities

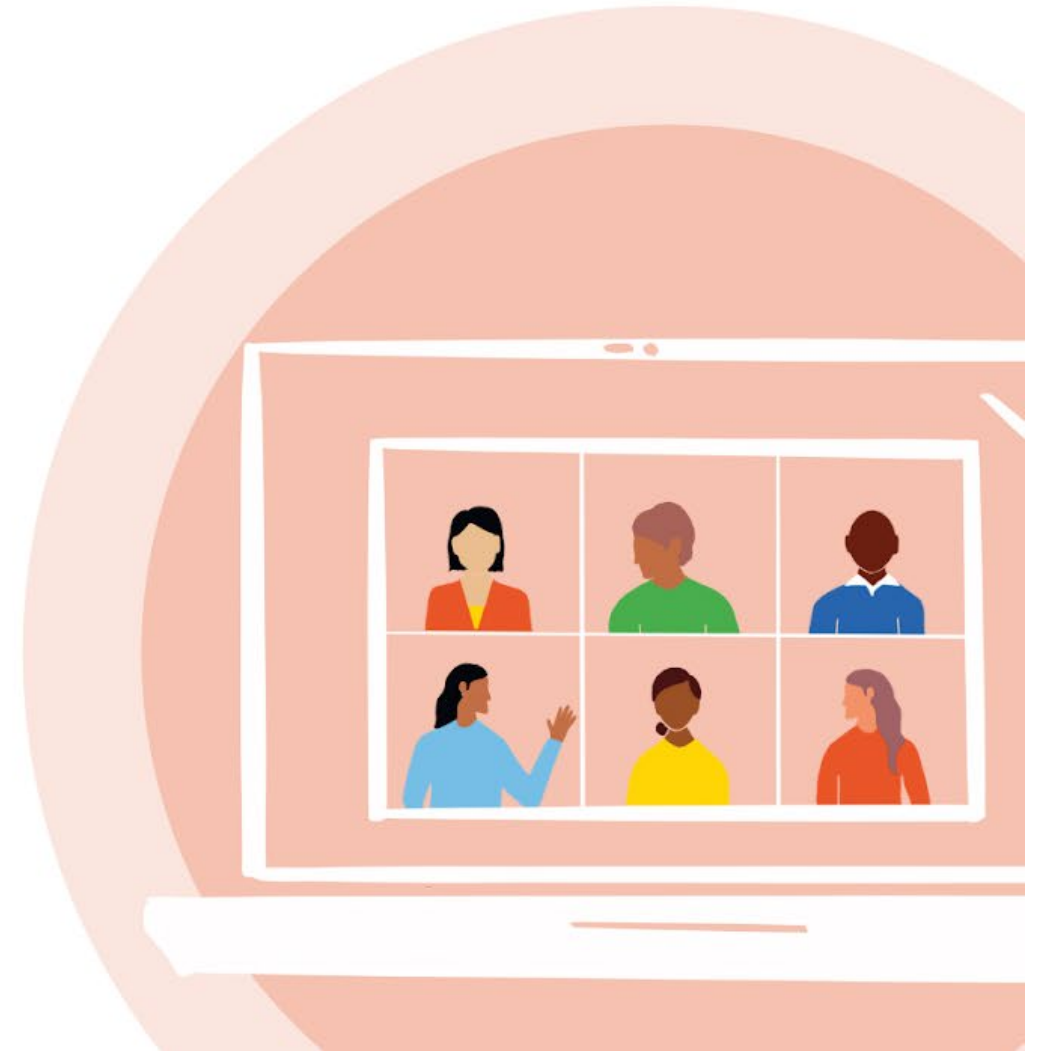
Next steps
