When you arrive

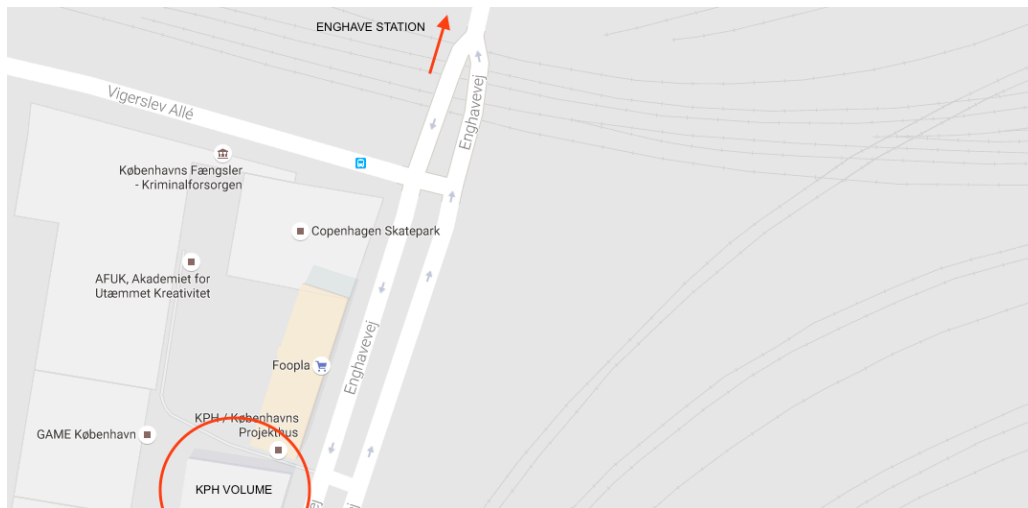

Where is the festival?

The festival is held in and around KPH Volume, Enghavevej 80-82, 2450 København SV

If you are coming to the festival by public transport we suggest that you take an S-train from the Main train station (Hovedbanegården) to Enghave Station. It's a 5 minute walk from Enghave Station to the festival venue.

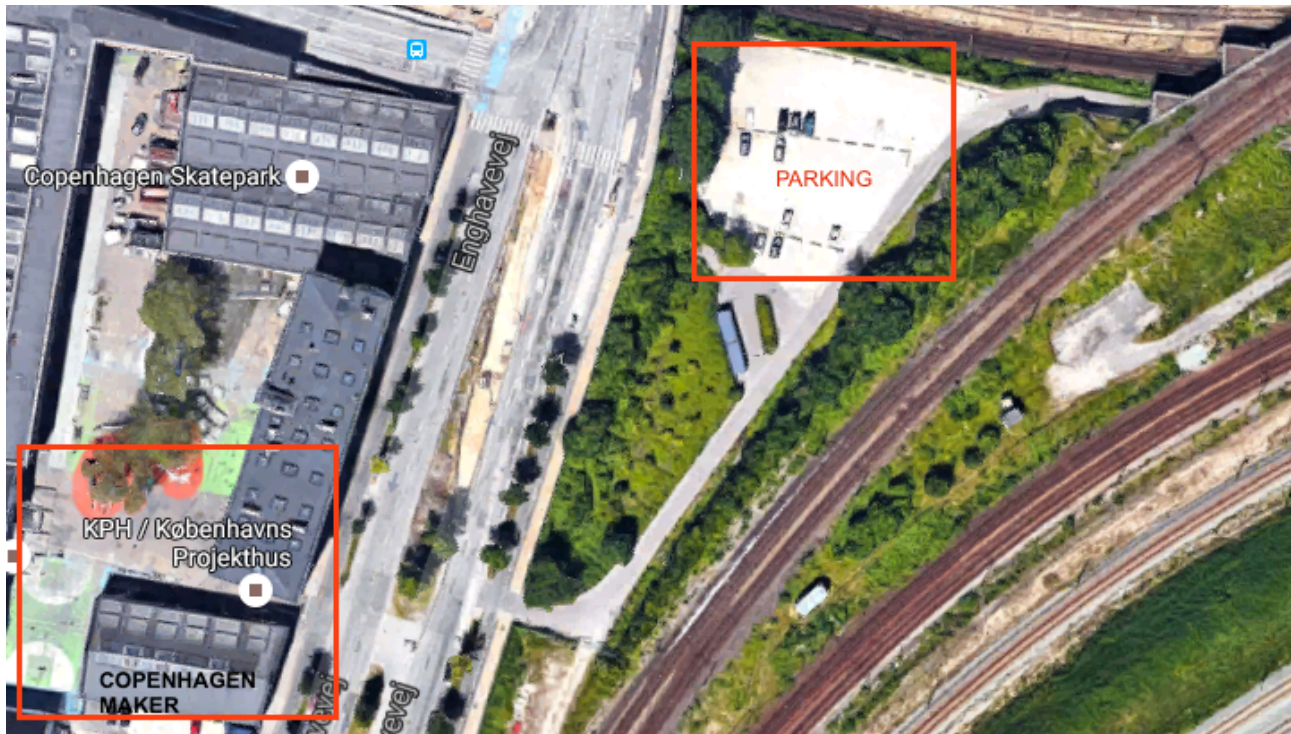


Access by car

If you have to unload/load vehicles, you are welcome to do so during the getin and getout times (see below). Outside these times there is no driving permitted at the festival venue!

Parking

There are no parking spaces at the venue. There is a parking space just across the street (see the map). Note that there is a parking fee!



Who's looking after my stuff at night?

We have a G4S guard at the venue from 23-7 between Friday-Saturday, and Saturday-Sunday. In the rest of the hours of the day, there will be staff at the venue. So you can leave the festival and get a night of worry-free rest.

Can I get in before Friday?

If you would like to drop off equipment/machines before Friday, you can come by during the following hours, if you have notified project manager Stine Broen by email beforehand (stine@cphmaker.dk)

Thursday 9/22, kl. 9-14 and 19-21

Please note:

This is only an option for people doing activities starting Friday 9/23!

We don't have anybody watching over your stuff during the nights. Please note that storing equipment and materials before Friday 9/23 is at own risk.

Can I leave my equipment at the festival when my activity has ended?

No, unfortunately we don't have storage space for storing equipment. The day your activity ends you will have to take it home.

When and how will I/we get our wristbands?

Your host will give you your wristbands when you arrive at the festival.

Guests

For each of you doing an activity, you will get an extra all-pass ticket for the festival. The all-pass tickets will be given to your contact person upon arrival.

Food and drinks

There will be 2 food trucks, a coffee truck and a bar selling soft drinks and beer at the festival.

Copenhagen Maker will provide you with 1 food and 1 drink ticket per person per day. The food and drink tickets will be given to you upon arrival by your host.

You can buy drinks at cost prize in the bar.
