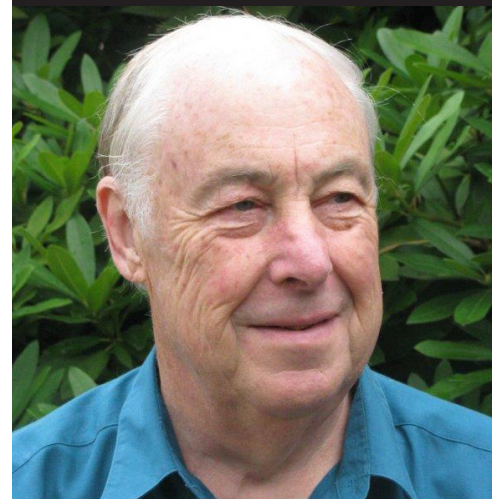
Bill Gammage is Emeritus Professor in the Humanities Research Centre at the Australian National University (ANU), researching Aboriginal land management at the time of contact.
