# CAPD

IN THE FIELD

## The CAPD story

CAPD was initially founded to provide capacity building opportunities for small disability organizations in Colombia. The Integration Program began as early as 1998 when a founding member of CAPD was living in Colombia and responded to the needs of children with disabilities and their families. CAPD was founded in 2001 to provide opportunities for growth for this organization and others like it. In 2010 the Green Light Education Assistance Program for low-income students was added. This program, which provides uniforms and school meals, has expanded to urban and rural areas in the departments of Santander and Risaralda. The Safe Water Program, initiated in 2011 in the department of Cordoba, provides a household water treatment system to rural families living without piped or treated water.

## Green Light Education Assistance



The Green Light Education Assistance Program helps children from low income families to stay in school by providing the noon meal and school uniforms. In 2013, the program gave 440 children access to a school lunch program while 680 received uniforms, shoes and a knapsack with school supplies.

## Integration Program



CAPD supports Colombian disability organizations, FANDIC and ASODISPIE, to build the capacity to become sustainable while fulfilling their missions of providing programs, and promoting integration through therapy, recreation, training workshops and small business opportunities.



## Safe Water Program

The Safe Water Program provides Household Water Treatment Systems to communities, in collaboration with the Canadian and Colombian Rotary Clubs. In 2013 the program provided filters to 1200 rural families in the state of Cordoba, Colombia. These families no longer worry about parasites and diarrhea from the water they drink. We plan to serve 1000 additional families in 2014.
