We are less than three weeks away from the third Mini Make Day event at Library at The Dock, and I wanted to touch base with you and let you know what has been going on.

Where: Library at The Dock is at 107 Victoria Harbour Promenade, Docklands 3008

Please bring any power boards or leads needed to drive your equipment, along with any signage you would like to display for your group. We will provide the tables for the event for your group.

Library at The Dock is at 107 Victoria Harbour Promenade, Docklands 3008.

There is a loading zone by the side of the library, which can be used for unloading and loading you're equipment. Please be aware that parking is limited in the area, and due to construction, parking bays along North Wharf Road may not be available.

Train: Get off at Sothern Cross station, and either walk or get a tram down to Library at The Dock. The Trams 11 and 48 can be caught on Collins St, and are in the Free Tram Zone, meaning there is no charge for the ride.

Trams: 11 and 48 towards Victoria Harbor stop nearly right out the front of the library at the last stop, D18. Then it is just a short walk forward and on the right you will see the library building.

If you are driving please allow time to find parking as there is very little. If you follow Collins Street until the very end, it turns into North Wharf Road and there is free parking at the end of this road which is around a 10 minute walk from the library. It is often full however so we do recommend public transport as the best option.
