Purpose of the ISSS

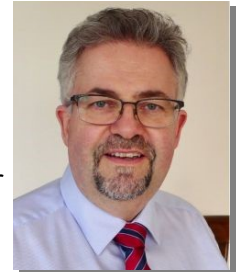
