Here is how you can participate:

STEP 1: Download the iNaturalist App
Create a user account at iNaturalist.org

STEP 2: Find Wildlife

Spot and observe plant and animal life in and around your home environment or neighborhood.

STEP 3: Photograph What You Find Note the location.

STEP 4: Share Your Observation

Post photos on Naturalist to share with fellow observers and scientists.

STEP 5: Help Identify Observations


