India Macro Flash

July Industrial Production Rises 13.8% YoY - Way Above Expectations; Capital Goods the Outlier, Up 63% YoY

- July industrial production up 13.8% July industrial production rose 13.8%, higher than our and consensus estimates (Citi 7.0%; Consensus 7.5%). Similar to last month, where incidentally the numbers were revised down from 7.1% to 5.8%, we were expecting single-digit growth in July due to the fading of the base effect. (A quick re-cap, industrial growth which had averaged 0.9% during Oct08-May09 picked up in Jun09 with growth during Jun09-Mar10 averaging 12.1%). The outlier in this month's number is capital goods, which rose 63% YoY v/s -0.3 last month. This is corroborated by trends seen in machinery and equipment up 49.4%, other equipment up 31.1% and transport equipment and parts up 24.9%. (pls see pages 2 and 4 for details).
- Capital goods: The outlier up 63%, consumer goods appears in line On a sectoral basis growth was led by mining (9.7%), manufacturing (15%) and electricity (3.7%). As regards the use-based classification, besides capital goods which were up 63%, trends in other segments were in line with past trends. Consumer goods rose 8.5% led by continued buoyancy in durables up 22.1% while non-durables remained weak rising 0.5%. Growth in Intermediate goods remained healthy, up 9.1%, while basic goods were up 5.1%.
- Implications Maintain growth and rate estimates While we could see a revision to the headline July numbers (on a MoM seasonally adjusted basis, growth was up 6.1% v/s 0.4% in the previous month), we are maintaining our 8.4% GDP estimate for FY11 led by 5% growth in agriculture and 9% in industry and services. On rates, taking into account trends in non-food credit, non-oil imports, inflation and growth, we expect the RBI to hike in its review on Sept 16 and maintain our view of a further 50bps of tightening in 2010. This would take the repo and reverse-repo rate to 6.25% and 5% by Dec 2010.

Data Highlights

Following the 5.8% growth in June, manufacturing activity rose 15% in July. On a cumulative basis growth during April-July came in at 12.2% v/s 4.4% in the same period last year.

The sectoral breakdown indicates 12 of 17 industries posted positive growth in July. The sectors that had the highest growth were machinery and equipment up 49.4%, other equipment up 31.1%, transport equipment up 24.9%, rubber and coal products up 19.4%, jute and vegetable fibres up 19.3% and metal products up 14.8%.

Sectors in the red included wood products (-9.4%), leather products (-1.8%), beverages and tobacco (-2.1%YoY) and textile products (-0.7%)

Figure 3. Monthly Trends in Industrial Production (%YoY)




Figure 4. Trends in Manufacturing (%YoY)




Figure 5. Trends in Mining and Electricity (%YoY, 3mma)




Figure 6. Trends in Basic and Intermediate Goods (%YoY, 3mma)




Figure 7. Trends in Capital Goods (%)





Figure 8. Trends in Consumer Goods (%YoY)
