Markets are likely to give back some the mammoth gains made yesterday in the opening session itself, though the closing will depend upon how the situation transpires in the US. A minor resistance comes in at 9720, beyond that Sensex can take an expressway to 10200.

### Finmin, RBI to meet today on Govt Borrowing

The finance ministry and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) are meeting today to decide on the government's borrowing requirement, which is more this year due to the impact of financial crisis and stimulus measures taken by the government. Economic Affairs Secretary Ashok Chawla told that the borrowing route will be decided in the most appropriate manner after consultation with the government and RBI who raises the debt

### Bajaj Auto tightens grip on Europe's KTM Sports

Two-wheeler industry may be down in the dumps, but that's not coming in the way of Bajaj Auto's global ambitions. The company is tightening its grip on KTM Power Sports, Europe's second-largest power sports bike manufacturer. Bajaj is hiking its stake in KTM from 25% to 30% to make the most of "low valuations". Bajaj Auto managing director Rajiv Bajaj told ET that the stake hike in KTM will be completed in 6-8 weeks. They have reached an agreement to increase stake in KTM. At this juncture, it won't be appropriate for me to talk about the valuations. It's happening at a time when the duo is working to roll out the high-powered KTM bikes in India. The KTM bikes, Duke and RR, based on two platforms, 125cc-180cc and 250cc-400cc, will be assembled at Bajaj Auto's Chakan facility.

### Indiabulls Real Estate warrants lapse

Indiabulls Real Estate Ltd has announced with reference to the earlier announcement dated August 09, 2007, regarding the allotment of 1,50,00,000 warrants made by the Company to the Promoters of the Company on a preferential basis, that as per the terms of issue of these warrants, upon payment of exercise price of Rs 300/- per warrant, as reduced by 10% upfront money paid at the time of allotment of warrants, the warrant holders were, within a period of eighteen months from the date of allotment of the said warrants, entitled to apply for and obtain allotment of one Equity share of face value Rs 2/- each fully paid-up of the Company, against each warrant held. The last date for exercise of such right was February 08, 2009.

Further the Company has informed that, the warrant holders have not exercised their right to convert their warrants into Equity shares of the Company by the said date and hence, the warrants allotted in their favor now stand lapsed

### IDBI and BOB give Satyam Rs 600 cr

State-owned IDBI Bank has given a Rs 300-crore loan to the fraud-hit Satyam Computer and the remaining Rs 300 crore has been offered by Bank of Baroda, said IDBI Bank Chairman and Managing Director Yogesh Agarwal. The government-appointed Satyam board had recently said that it secured Rs 600-crore bank loans, which would help it fulfil its immediate fund requirements.

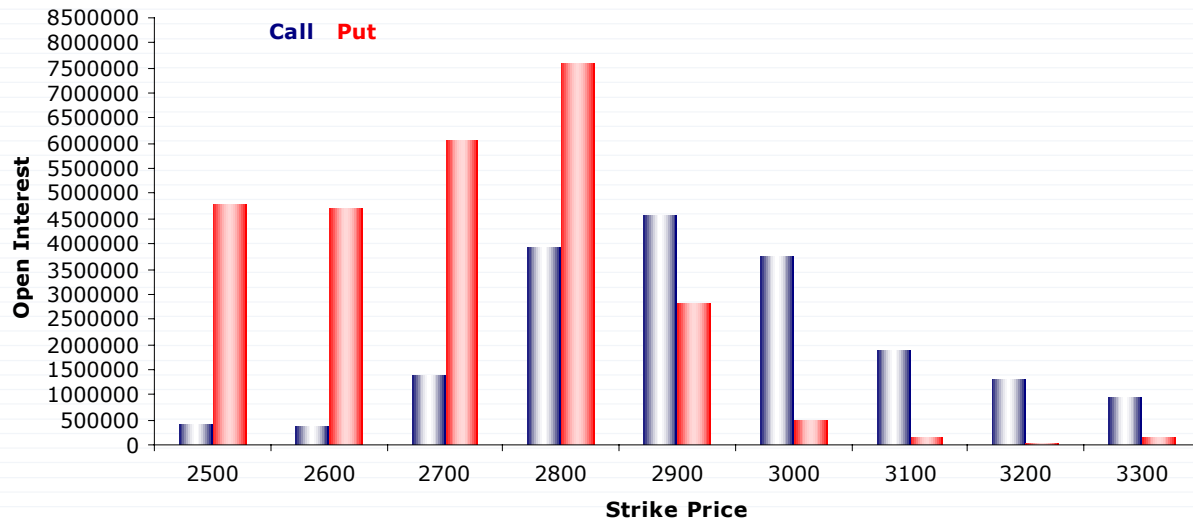
- ❖ Nifty Feb Future closed at 2911.50, a Discount of 8 Points. (Yesterday Discount of 12 Points).
- ❖ Overall Open interest in value terms increased by whopping Rs 4,254 Cr or 9.02% to Rs 51,426 Cr while in Number of share terms OI went up by 3.97% to 122.12 Cr from 117.45 Cr shares.
- ❖ Nifty futures added massive 8% in OI while Nifty Feb future discount trimmed further to 8 points from 12 points indicating long positions being built in Nifty.
- ❖ FIIs net bought worth Rs 345 Cr in Index futures with their OI going up by 24,199 contracts, suggesting long positions being built by them in Nifty.
- ❖ Nifty OI PCR moved up sharply to reach at highest level of the current series to 1.34 level, from 1.20 level on the back of aggressive put writing at 2800 & 2900 level indicating market players expect market to find very strong support in the region of 2850-2900 level.
- ❖ Stock futures added 2.80 Cr shares (3.16%) in OI while derivative stocks saw average price rise of 2.5% indicating long positions being built across the board particularly in Reliance group and construction/Infra stocks.
- ❖ Among the stocks long positions being built in stocks like Bombay Dyeing, Century Text, GVK Power, India Cement, JP Associate, MRPL, Punj Lloyd, Reliance, Rel Infra, RPL and Tata steel.

## ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

The US markets rally was put in a pause mode as the stimulus bill passage got postponed by a day.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average ended down 9.72 points, or 0.1%, at 8270.87, but the S&P 500 added 1.29 points, or 0.1%, to 869.89. The Nasdaq edged down 0.15 points, or 0.01%, to 1591.56.

**Bank of America** and GE were the best performers on the Dow, rising 12.4% and 13.9%, respectively. Banks in general were higher, with the **KBW banking index** rising 2.2%, following a strong showing at the end of last week, which was thought to be in anticipation of the coming bank bailout plan.

Treasury Secretary **Timothy Geithner** was scheduled to present his overhaul of said financial rescue plan Monday, but has been delayed until Tuesday. Two concepts, among others, that could be dealt with are a so-called "bad bank" to buy up toxic assets from struggling financial institutions and the potential suspension of the mark-to-market rule.

Analysts think the bad bank will be far smaller than first envisioned, with purchases limited to those assets already marked down significantly.

The Senate is now expected to pass on Tuesday the **\$827 billion stimulus bill**, which has been hindered by partisan disagreements.

Japanese automaker **Nissan** down 3.7% to \$5.98, posted a quarterly loss and said it will cut 20,000 jobs or 8.5% of its global work force, over the next year, morphing to handle the economic downturn.

Also, **General Motors**, in a story first reported by Bloomberg, said it will cut up to 5,000 jobs, a cost-cutting effort to try to meet a March 31 deadline that will determine if the automaker can keep \$13.4 billion in government aid. In addition, today it was reported that the automaker may seek to take back ownership of parts supplier –Delphi, which it spun off years ago, in order to qualify for more government loans. Its shares retracted 0.4% to \$2.83.

In earnings, **Beazer Homes** narrowed its loss to \$2.08, but it was still worse than predicted. **NYSE Euronext** also missed expectations, with a 20% decline in quarterly profit.

Nonetheless, Beazer rose 19 cents, or 19%, to \$1.19; NYSE Euronext, however, shed 5.2% to \$21.71.

One bright spot was **McDonald's**, which reported a 7.1% global gain in same-store sales. Shares of the hamburger maker rose almost 1% to \$59.02.

Taking a look at commodities, **crude oil** fell 61 cents to settle at **\$39.56**, while **gold** gave up \$22.50 to settle at **\$892.80**.
