* JAL will be delisted from Tokyo stock exchange

Japan Airlines Corp. will file for bankruptcy protection. The airline's shares will be delisted from the Tokyo Stock Exchange and 15,700 jobs will be cut over three years along with about a quarter of JAL's group companies. Also, 17 loss-making international routes and 17 domestic routes will be eliminated.

* Japan's consumer confidence down in Dec.

Japan's consumer confidence slipped in December, down for the second straight month. The index for general households, which tracks consumers' outlooks on employment and incomes, stood at 37.6, down from 39.5 in November.

* Kraft agrees to buy Cadbury

Kraft Foods has agreed to buy Cadbury in a deal worth around 11.9 billion pounds (\$19.5 billion). Kraft will pay 500 pence and 0.1874 of its own shares for every Cadbury share, or the equivalent of roughly 840 pence a share in total. In addition, Cadbury holders will receive a dividend of 10 pence a share.
