Reliance failed to create a lasting flutter in the markets. The Sensex did an early jig but was later weighed down by weakness in ITC and Cement stocks. The Sensex traded in the region of 13056-12844, which was with in the over all range of 13145 and 12788. The markets effectively did not go anywhere. In other words we call it consolidation.

Sugar stocks were seen doing well. There appears to be limited upside to the sector, which will have to be reviewed after the sowing stats are out in the open. Though the initial number is not very encouraging, the sector has the momentum going for it at this point. Cement and ITC saw fresh shorts yesterday. The next trigger forward could come when these shorts are covered. For the time being the market is in the 13145-12788 range.

HALLIBURTON shifts its HQ to Dubai

Oilfield services giant, Halliburton will move its corporate headquarters from Houston to Dubai, the company announced Sunday. Halliburton, once run by Vice President Dick Cheney, plans to maintain a corporate office in Houston, but the company will be run from its new headquarters in the United Arab Emirates.

The shift is part of a strategic plan to focus on expanding relation with state-owned oil companies. "The eastern hemisphere is a market that is more heavily weighted toward oil exploration and production opportunities and growing our business here will bring more balance to Halliburton's overall portfolio," the CEO said in a statement.

Last year, 38% of Halliburton's \$13 billion in oil field services revenue was generated in the eastern hemisphere. The company, which was founded in 1919, operates in almost 70 countries and has more than 45,000 employees.

Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks closed higher Monday, as fresh concerns over the subprime-lender market failed to lead to heavy losses and a batch of big mergers helped to give investors an upbeat tone.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** rose 42.30 points, or 0.34% to 12,318.62. The index had spent much of the day near the flat line, and earlier was down as much as 30 points.

Nineteen of the Dow's 30 components finished in the black, led by gains of 1.9% or more in **Intel** and **Boeing**.

Meanwhile, the **S&P 500** ended up 3.75 points, or 0.27%, at 1406.60, and the **Nasdaq Composite** added 14.74 points, or 0.62%, to 2402.29.

Among the sectoral winners were the Amex Airline Index, which was higher by 1.3%. The Philadelphia Semiconductor Sector Index rose 0.9%, and the S&P Retail Index tacked on 0.5%.

Among losers, the Philadelphia Housing Sector Index fell 2.2%. The Amex Oil Index slid 0.4%, and the Philadelphia/KBW Bank Index dipped 0.1%.

As is often the case, the new week started with the announcement of several takeover deals. The biggest will see New Jersey's **Schering-Plough** pay \$14.5 billion for the Organon BioSciences unit of the Netherlands' **Akzo Nobel** . Schering-Plough added 10 cents, or 0.4%, to \$23.95.

Staying in the health care sector, **UnitedHealth** will acquire **Sierra Health Services** in a deal worth \$2.6 billion. Sierra, which is valued at \$43.50 a share in the transaction, jumped 15.8% to end at \$41.57

Elsewhere, **Ford** confirmed that it will sell its Aston Martin business in a deal that values the brand at \$925 million. Ford will retain a \$77 million stake in the business. The automaker's shares eased 11 cents, or 1.4%, at \$7.82.

Among analyst moves, UBS downgraded embattled **New Century Financial** to reduce from neutral. The firm joins those who believe New Century will be forced to declare bankruptcy.

Shares of New Century, which started the year at \$31.59, were halted for the session at \$3.21 on the NYSE as the exchange reviewed the situation.

UBS also upgraded retailers **Kohl's** and **J.C. Penney** to buy from neutral. Kohl's was 0.3% higher, and J.C. Penney gained 1.5%.

Away from stocks, commodity prices were weaker. Energy was on the decline, with **oil** slipping \$1.14 to finish at **\$58.91** a barrel. Natural gas fell 17 cents to \$6.91 per million British thermal units. Gold gave back \$1.70 at \$650.30 an ounce.
