VIEW POINT: ALL DEPENDS ON BOJ

The Sensex lost 150 points Tuesday, as the benchmark digested its 674 points rise from the recent low of 13805 seen on the Valentine's day. I see this as consolidation. But any fall from here , should be seen as renewed weakness, though you could stretch the limit of your tolerance to 14,000 mark.

It would be naïve to judge the markets on technicals alone. The direction of the markets will depend on the outcome of the BOJ meeting. So do not read too much into the current derivative data or charts. A hike by BOJ will result in our markets taking an early morning hit. If BOJ stays where it is, the markets are likely to stage a recovery, as short covering will chase the Nifty higher.

Bank of Japan: The suspense continues

While the larger evidence in the run up to the BOJ meeting was one that favoured a hike, two events Monday, may give the bank a reason not to hike it's rates from the present 0.25% to 0.5%.

The first is an appeal by the Japanese Finance Minister that he wants the Bank of Japan to keep supporting economic growth with its monetary policy. Secondly, activity in Japan's service sector fell for the second straight month in December as warm weather damped retail trade, adding to speculation that consumer spending in the world's second-largest economy has yet to fully recover.

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Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks rose on Tuesday, sending the Dow Jones Industrial Average to a record closing level, as reassuring comments from Federal Reserve Governor Susan Bies, along with upbeat results from Wal-Mart Stores Inc. and merger news, helped offset disappointing earnings from Home Depot.

Bies' comments led the market to believe that the Fed is not in tightening mode right now, while she also sounded reassuring about the housing market and credit markets.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** was down by as many as 62 points earlier before rallying to end up 19.07 points, or 0.15%, to 12,786.64, its fourth straight record finish. Aiding the Dow's turnaround were gains in retail components **Wal-Mart** and **Home Depot** . Overall, 16 of the 30 industrials finished the day in positive territory.

The **S&P 500** rose 4.14 points to1459.68, and the **Nasdaq Composite** added 16.73 points to finish at 2513.04.

As Wall Street traders returned from a long weekend, they were greeted by word that satellite-radio rivals **XM** and **Sirius** will try to make a go of it as a single company. Shareholders of each company will own about half of the new firm. XM surged 10.2% to \$15.41, and Sirius shares jumped 6% to close at \$3.92.

Meanwhile, **Wal-Mart** topped analysts' fourth-quarter earnings estimates and offered in-line guidance for the first quarter and full year. The retail giant had a quarterly profit of 95 cents a share on revenue of \$99.1 billion. Analysts were calling for earnings of 90 cents a share and revenue of \$99.6 billion. Shares rose \$1.78, or 3.7%, to \$50.26.

Home Depot, like Wal-Mart a member of the Dow, posted an adjusted quarterly profit of 50 cents a share, matching the consensus forecast. However, sales of roughly \$20.3 billion were about \$500 million below expectations. Home Depot finished a choppy session down 10 cents, or 0.2%, to \$41.34.

Major commodities were uniformly lower at the New York Mercantile Exchange. The March **crude oil** contract, which expired at the end of the session, slid \$1.32 to close at **\$58.07** a barrel, and **gold** dropped \$11.80 to **\$661** an ounce.

By sector, miners and precious metals were hit hardest. The Philadelphia Gold & Silver index slipped 1.8%. Also losing ground was the Philadelphia Oil Service Sector index, which sank 1%. Among winners, the Nasdag Transportation index rose 1.2%, and the Amex Airlines index added 0.8%.
