Markets drifted lower Tuesday as expected and are likely to continue doing that on Wednesday as sub-prime woes melt down hedge funds and techies fail to deliver in post market unveiling of results late Tuesday in the US. A 200-point plunge in the Nikkei seems to be ominous.

The Open Interest at Rs 85,701 Cr is at an all time high. Though it is not a concern at this point of time, it could become one if the Nifty commits hara-kiri. The Nifty appears to be losing momentum. The joker in the pack could be Reliance, which finally joined the indices in making a new high, after being in a reclusive mood since May 23rd. Lighten commitments elsewhere.

SUB-PRIME WOES AGAIN

The flirted with the 14,000 mark again Tuesday, but the rally couldn't sustain itself into the closing bell. Perhaps there's just too much rumbling below in the credit markets to justify such a cork-popping event, even with a growing list of strong earnings reports and news of more mergers

Indeed, traders spent much of the day chattering about the true losses at two **Bear Stearns** hedge funds -- the High-Grade Structured Credit Strategies Fund and its sister vehicle, High Grade Structured Credit Enhanced Leveraged Fund.

In March, the more highly levered fund had \$638 million in equity, and the less levered fund had \$925 million, according to *The Wall Street Journal*

According to media Bear Stearns told investors in the hedge funds late Tuesday they are worth virtually nothing, with the more highly levered fund worth zero cents on the dollar, and the less leveraged fund worth 9% of its value at the end of April. A Bear Stearns press release is expected later Tuesday.

The fear is that such a worst-case scenario with the valuations could cause many more funds than expected to mark-to-market their portfolios. The next domino would be banks further tighten the strings on their lending to hedge funds through their prime brokerage business. This means investors that borrow to invest may have to pay more for the money they've been using. This might mean funds sell other assets to cover those costs, and that could include high-yield bonds and leveraged loans, both of which have also suffered losses of late.

Subprime concerns will likely be on the docket during **Federal Reserve** Chairman Ben Bernanke's semiannual testimony on Capitol Hill.

Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks closed mixed Tuesday, with upbeat earnings sending the Dow Jones Industrial Average to a record high finish, but just shy of 14,000, a level it topped earlier in the day

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** marched past the 14,000 mark for the first time ever Tuesday -- less than three months after it crossed 13,000 -- but it wasn't able to hold on.

Several times during trading the Dow went above the milestone. However, by the close it was showing a gain of just 20.57 points, or 0.15%, at 13,971.55. Still that was good enough for a fourth straight record finish.

The **Nasdaq** was better by 14.96 points, or 0.55%, at 2712.29. The **S&P 500** lagged, easing by 0.15 point, or 0.01%, to close at 1549.37.

Energy prices made a push above \$75 a barrel, but the front-month August contract took a turn south and was down 13 cents to \$74.02 a barrel. Gasoline prices fell 2.5 cents to \$2.10 a gallon.

Meanwhile, earnings were beginning to flow in at full force, but dealmaking news managed to steal some of the spotlight.

News Corp has reached a tentative deal to buy the paper's parent company **Dow Jones** for \$5 billion. However, the report said some of the Bancrofts, the family that controls Dow, still had reservations.

News Corp. was higher by 62 cents, or 2.6%, to close at \$24.25. Dow Jones eased 50 cents, or 0.9%, to \$56.45.

Elsewhere, Basell of the Netherlands, whose offer for **Huntsman** was recently turned down, agreed to acquire **Lyondell** for \$48 a share, or more than \$12 billion. Lyondell surged \$6.93, or 17.3%, to \$47.05.

In the energy sector, **Plains Exploration** said it would take over rival **Pogo Producing** in a cash and stock deal valued at \$3.6 billion. Plains Exploration fell 6.5% to \$47.88, while Pogo Producing jumped 13.9% to close at \$57.50

As for earnings, **Coca-Cola** topped analysts' second-quarter estimates and said revenue jumped to \$7.73 billion from \$6.48 billion a year earlier. The stock shed 68 cents, or 1.3%, to \$53.17.

Merrill Lynch and Johnson & Johnson were also better than expected, as were KeyCorp and State Street.

Novartis , though, lowered its forecast. Shares ended the day with a loss of \$1.32, or 2.4%, to \$54.13.

The earnings torrent continues Wednesday, with releases expected from **Altria**, **eBay**, **JPMorgan Chase** and **Pfizer** among others.

Even with the abundance of corporate news, both stock and bond traders also had to contend with incoming data for clues about the overall health of the economy. Before the opening bell, **the Labor Department** said its **producer price index** for June showed that inflation ticked higher at the wholesale level.

The headline index fell 0.2%, below projections for a 0.2% rise. The core index, which excludes food and energy, rose a greater-than-expected 0.3%. The core rate has advanced 1.8% year over year, up from May's 1.6% rise, but within the **Federal Reserve's** comfort range for inflation of 1% to 2%

AFTER HOURS: Techies disappoint

Shares of **Intel** fell more than 4% Tuesday evening after the chipmaker's quarterly gross margin fell below expectations, and **Yahoo** shares fell after the Internet search firm posted a slight decline in quarterly profit.

Elsewhere, shares of **Bear Stearns Cos**. fell on worries about hedge funds related to the subprime mortgage market.

The **Nasdaq-100 After Hours Indicator**, which tracks extended trading in the tech-heavy index's leading stocks, dropped 10 points to 2,031.53.
