As we enter the last four days of the September series, we find that the Open Interest (OI) has risen to an all time high mark of Rs 95,471 cr. This obviously includes the 14 newly baptized stocks that joined the bandwagon on 6th September, which have together added Rs 958 Cr to the OI. In the current settlement, there is good chance that we may see, the six digit mark being crossed for the first time in history in this week. The markets are in a carnival mood. Join the revelry with eyes open.

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THE INDICATOR**At the street****FRENZY AFTER A LONG TIME**

The markets were in a tearing hurry last week, with the Nifty rising 7% and the Sensex following it up with a 6% rise. More than the rise in the indices, it was the run away boom in stocks like Reliance Petro (RPL) and Reliance Natural Resources (RNRL) that caught the fancy of the investors.

RPL rose 11% on Friday and 16% for the week for no apparent reason. RNRL rose a mind boggling 35% after news came in that the company had applied for gas distribution licenses in four cities. This resulted in renewed interest in all Reliance stocks, irrespective to which group the stock belonged.

What should investors do in such a scenario? Before we answer this question lets peep into history and see what happens to what stocks when suddenly they rise. The last occasion, when a F&O stock rose sharply was India Infoline, when it surged 27% on 28th May earlier this year, accompanied by a 67% rise in OI. It went on to rise 5% the next day, 3 % the next and another 6% the following day, before beginning to correct.

It may not be out of place to expect the Reliance siblings to rise further going forward if history is anything to go by. Short sellers can get skinned at such times. If you believe that a stock a stock has run with out any rhyme or reason, short it with a stop loss or buy a put.

The kind of surge we are now seeing in the markets is usually seen in two kinds of scenarios. One is the re-rating of the markets and the second is the last stage of a bull market, where prices can rise in a crescendo before falling in a heap. The optimal thing to do in such a scenario is to be with the current. If you want too swim against the current, do by all means, but wear the safety belt of a Put option.

And if you are in camp that is annoyed with what is happening in the market, it is better to stay away rather than try and teach the rampaging bulls a lesson. There are many times, like these, when what is happening in the markets, is not to your liking. It is best to keep your cool and do a bit of gardening or take a brake and rush to the Himalayas for nice autumn trek, where negotiating a glacier will have less danger and unpleasant surprises than running after a stock on Dalal street.

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As things stand on the weekend, the current settlement is likely to end on smooth note, with the bulls in charge. The rollovers are higher for both the Nifty and the Stock Futures as compared to the last month. If you are long, it is always advisable to not to rollover your positions immediately but wait for the last day and carry over positions only if the trend id positive. Don't lose your balance and play it cool.

THE INDICATOR**Across the Atlantic**

U.S. stocks climbed Friday, with the Dow industrials scoring its largest weekly gain since March, as positive earnings from Oracle Corp. and Nike Inc. spurred optimism amid high volume triggered by expiring futures and options contracts

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** gained 53.49 points, or 0.39%, to 13,820.19. The **S&P 500** was up 7 points, or 0.46%, to 1525.75. The **Nasdaq Composite** was better by 16.93 points, or 0.64%, to 2671.22.

For the major indices, it was their second winning week in a row, mostly thanks to the **Federal Reserve's** 50-basis-point interest rate cut on Tuesday. The Dow and the S&P 500 both climbed 2.8% for the week, and the Nasdaq added 2.7%.

Crude oil pulled back a day after setting yet another record. The newly benchmarked November contract finished down 16 cents to \$81.62 a barrel, but ended 4.5% higher on the week.

Gold lost \$1 at **\$738.90** an ounce, while silver rose 15 cents to end the day at \$13.62 an ounce. The **dollar** again was weaker against most other major currencies, including the euro and the Canadian dollar.

U.S. Treasury prices were stronger after a multisection slide. The 10-year note was up 16/32 in price, yielding 4.63%. The 30-year bond was adding 1 4/32, reducing the yield to 4.89%.

Meanwhile, traders also had to deal with **options expiration**. Derivatives contracts on single-stock futures, stock options, index futures and index options all traded for the last time. The simultaneous expiration happens quarterly and can lead to considerable swings in the market.

The economic docket was empty, but there were several Fed officials out with comments. **Fed Governor Fred Mishkin** delivered a speech on monetary policy in Germany, referencing the latest policy meeting when he said that the central bank needs to make "informed guesses" about policy.

Another late-day reporter, **Nike** handily beat fiscal first-quarter earnings and revenue targets. However, Nike was off \$1.06, or 1.8%, closing at \$57.26.

Elsewhere, **Texas Instruments** was up after the chipmaker raised its dividend by 25% to 10 cents a share. TI also added a buyback of up to \$5 billion in stock. Shares climbed 85 cents, or 2.4%, to \$36.62.
