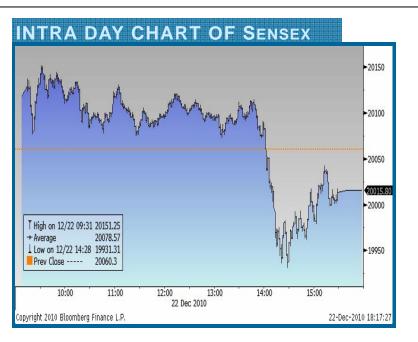

India stock market opened on a firm note following the other Asian markets and continued to trade in the positive zone. However, it fell in the second half of trade on account of profit booking following weak start of European peers and decline in Reliance Industries on gas cost report. As per media reports, production costs at two of the company's natural gas fields in the Krishna-Godavari basin have shot up nearly 40 percent because of low output. Market ended the session on a weak note, snapping a three-day winning streak.

Nifty closed at 5,984.40, down by 16.25 points or 0.27 percent over the previous day closing of 6,000.65, after witnessing a low of 5,958.00 and a high of 6,023.80. Sensex closed at 20,015.80, down by 44.52 points or 0.22 percent over the previous day closing of 20,060.32. It touched an intraday low of 19,931.31 and high of 20,151.25.

The markets' breadth was positive. Out of 3,061 stocks traded, 1,504 stocks advanced, 1,399 stocks declined and 158 stocks remained unchanged. In Sensex, 15 stocks advanced, 14 stocks declined and 1 remained unchanged.

Among the sectors, BSE Oil & Gas, BSE Capital Goods and BSE Bankex were the main losers of the day, which declined by 0.71 percent, 0.61 percent and 0.55 percent respectively.

In BSE Oil & Gas sector, Petronet LNG, Reliance Industries and Cairn India declined by 1.44 percent, 1.34 percent and 0.70 percent respectively. In BSE Capital Goods sector, Gammon India, Suzlon Energy and Crompton Greaves declined by 2.35 percent, 2.07 percent and 1.79 percent respectively. In BSE Bankex sector, PNB, Bank of India and Federal Bank declined by 1.73 percent, 1.26 percent and 0.94 percent respectively.

# **OUTLOOK**

Indian stock market is likely to trade range bound without giving clear directions. The U.S. GDP data for the 3rd quarter may set some direction in market. We recommend buying in stocks like Renuka Sugars, Tata Elexi, IFCI, Aditya Birla Nuvo, Bharat Forge, Escorts, IDBI Bank and IOB with trading perspective and also for long term investment.

# **NEWS**



- Reliance Industries and Russia's SIBUR formed a joint venture for production of Butyl rubber in India. The JV facility will have an initial capacity of 100,000 tonnes of butyl rubber at RIL's integrated refining-cum-petrochemical site in Jamnagar and is expected to be commissioned by 2013.
- Tata Chemicals unveiled its first national brand of pulses and launched four popular varieties of pulses i.e. chana, toor, urad and moong dal.
- Tata Consultancy Services and Hilton Worldwide signed a multi-year agreement to enhance Hilton Worldwide's technology strategy as part of the Hilton Worldwide Innovation Collaborative.
- ONGC and Russian conglomerate Sistema are going to merge their oil & gas businesses in Russia under a joint venture in a no-cash deal where the Indian firm will have a 25 percent shareholding with a say in management.
- Tata Power signed an agreement to sell power generated at its 25 megawatt solar photovoltaic project at Mithapur to Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam.
- Maruti Suzuki is likely to witness 30 percent rise in its overall sales volume in the fiscal year ending March 2011 over the last year. However, its market share may fall in the financial year beginning April 1, 2011, according to the company.
- NHPC signed an agreement with Jammu & Kashmir State Power Development Corporation and PTC India for formation of a joint venture company for execution of Pakal Dul and other Hydro-Electric Projects aggregating to installed capacity of about 2100 MW in the Chenab River Basin of Jammu & Kashmir.
- Dr. Reddy's Laboratories entered into a licensing, technology transfer, manufacturing and marketing agreement with R-Pharm of Russia. The collaboration is in the area of high-technology and works on a profit sharing model.
- Simplex Infrastructure in consortium with Patel Engineering and B S Transcomm bagged project for establishment of 765 KV transmission system associated with Krishnapattam Ultra Mega Power Plant. The build-operate-own-maintain project from REC Transmission Projects is estimated to be around INR300 crore.
- State Bank of Travancore will hold a board meeting on December 28, 2010 to consider the Rights Issue for shareholders.
- LGS Global bagged first e-governance project from government of Andhra Pradesh for Cooperative Oilseeds Grower's Federation. LGS Global will provide design, development and implementation of web based ERP packages.
- Bajaj Hindusthan Sugar & Industries fixed December 31 as record date for determining the shareholders of BHSIL who will he entitled to receive One equity share of the Bajaj Hindusthan for every 5 shares of BHSIL.
- Kavveri Telecom's subsidiary Kavveri Telecom Infrastructure signed a long agreement for ten years on Build-own-operate- lease basis with Seventh Operator for the in-building wireless solutions.
- J.Kumar Infraprojects received work orders worth INR36.85 crores for remolding and widening of existing box cell culvert at Eastern Express Highway for INR19.25 crores and pilling work orders from various parties including L&T, Era Infra etc for INR17.60 crores.
- Patel Engineering bagged project for establishment of 765 KV transmission system associated with Krishnapattam Ultra Mega Power Plant. The project from REC Transmission Projects Company will be based on build-operate-own-maintain basis.
