VIEW POINT: FED DOESN'T OBLIGE

The US FOMC did not play to the gallery as expected and kept its inflation fighting gear on. The markets, however, first slumped and then recovered to close with modest gains. Our take on the US markets, post the FOMC meetings, has been that it usually moves in the opposite direction, the next day. Our markets, like always, would be affected more by how Asia behaves, which needs to be studied before our open because of the fickle-minded nature of the oriental markets these days.

The modifications in the ECB guidelines by RBI on Tuesday would make the Rupee depreciate against the dollar and help the cause of the exporters, especially IT. In terms of the resistance, the Sensex has it at 15,142 and Nifty at 4,410. Supports exist at 14,705 and 4,267 respectively.

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THE INDICATOR**At the Street****Changed ECB guidelines may weaken Rupee**

The government Tuesday stepped in to check foreign currency inflows by putting up stiff restrictions on overseas borrowings, a measure sought by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to enable it to check the rupee's sharp appreciation against the dollar.

External commercial borrowings (ECB) above \$20 million have now been allowed only for foreign currency expenditure for permissible end-uses and are required to park them overseas. Overseas borrowings for meeting rupee expenditure will henceforth be only after obtaining prior RBI approval, and will need to keep the funds overseas till actually required for making payments. That will mean less Dollars to be mopped up and consequently a weaker Rupee.

The finance ministry statement said the revised ECB guidelines would not apply to borrowers who already have loans agreements and obtained loan registration numbers from RBI. The annual per company ECB cap of \$500 million has been kept unchanged.

THE INDICATOR**Across the Atlantic**

Stocks riding a wave of volatility that had the Dow Jones Industrials swinging 100-points in either direction on Tuesday closed with modest gains after the Federal Reserve's largely optimistic take on U.S. economic growth

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** rose by 35.32 points, or 0.26%, to 13,504.30. The index had fallen by as many as 121 points and then leaped by as many as 139 points after the Fed's 2:15 p.m. EDT announcement.

The **S&P 500** rose 9.04 points, or 0.62%, to 1476.71, while the **Nasdaq Composite** climbed 14.27 points, or 0.56%, to 2561.60.

The **Federal Reserve Open Market Committee**, as expected, kept its fed funds target rate at 5.25% for the ninth straight meeting. The only alteration in the Fed's statement was the addition of comments on the recent credit crisis.

Traders had been hoping that the Fed would take the credit-market troubles into account in its statement, but they also were seeking signs that the debt woes would lead policymakers to cut rates in the near future.

But **the Fed maintained that inflation is a main concern**, saying, "a sustained moderation in inflation pressures has yet to be convincingly demonstrated." That echoed comments from the previous statement in late June, and doesn't leave much room for a rate cut.

Any future rate changes, the Fed said in repeating past comments, will depend on the outlook for both inflation and economic growth, as indicated by incoming data

After tumbling 4.5% yesterday, the September front-month oil contract added 36 cents at \$72.42 a barrel. Gasoline was unchanged at \$1.93 a gallon.

Before the bell, the Labor Department said that second-quarter productivity rose 1.8%, short of expectations for a 2% increase. Meanwhile, first-quarter productivity was revised to a gain of 0.7%, compared to the previously reported 1% rise.

Several finance and mortgage names again made headlines. Lender **Countrywide**, which tumbled 16% last week amid fears of a credit crunch, said it will purchase the retail-mortgage operations of **HomeBanc** for an undisclosed sum. HomeBanc intends to exit the mortgage-loan origination business. Countrywide closed higher by 60 cents, or 2.2%, to \$27.35

Away from earnings, **Apple** hosted a media event where it unveiled an update to its iMac line of computers. Shares dipped 22 cents, or 0.2%, to close at \$135.03.

Luminent Mortgage faced four separate downgrades after it canceled filing its second-quarter earnings report and called off its conference call, scheduled for Thursday morning. The company also suspended its 32-cent dividend just a week after assuring investors that the payout was "secure."
