#### **VIEW POINT: UPWARDLY BOUND**

The markets surged Wednesday higher after being range bound for the first two days of the week. Both the Nifty and the Sensex are on course to eclipse their intermediate highs made on 26<sup>th</sup> of April. The resistance for the Nifty is at 4217 and at 14383 for the Sensex. Technology remains the mill stone around the markets neck. However, one need to be on the watch out, for a possible break out, though the charts do not foretell an up-move.

The Bank of Japan meets today, but no one expects BOJ to hike, in view of the weaker than expected Q1 GDP growth of 2.4%. Most of the action in derivatives has been happening in the Real Estate sector, where positions were built as prices soared. More than 50% of the OI, added Wednesday is in the newly recruited 31 stocks. The large caps, barring SBI, which have not moved their heavy bottoms, may do so today.

### 1. Housing Off to a Good Start

- The Commerce Department reported that housing starts hit a seasonally adjusted annual pace of 1.528 million units, above estimates for a 1.490 million pace.
- Oh, and March was revised down from 1.518 million to 1.491 million.
- Also, Building Permits, an indication of future building plans, dropped 8.9%, the slowest pace since 1997.
- The contortions required to pen the "Housing Starts Are Off to a Good Start" piece are apparent if one considers that Housing Starts are still down a whopping 16% year-over--year, and if one simply looks at the long-term chart below for some perspective.

#### **Across the Atlantic**

U.S. stocks rallied Wednesday, sending the Dow Jones Industrial Average to a new record high, as investors cheered stronger-than-expected industrial production data, Bausch & Lomb's buyout by a private equity firm and speculation about a break-up of Citigroup Inc

For the **Dow Jones Industrial Average**, that meant another best-ever finish. This time, the index rose 103.69 points, or 0.77%, to 13,487.53. Earlier, the Dow had been down by 20 points before rebounding for its 23rd record of 2007.

Meanwhile, the **S&P 500** added 12.95 points, or 0.86%, to 1514.14, and the **Nasdaq** finished ahead by 22.13 points, or 0.88%, at 2547.42.

Supporting the advance was a 4% gain in component **Citigroup** and a 2% increase in **Johnson & Johnson** . Helping Citi, and by extension the financial sector, was word that hedge fund manager Ed Lampert has taken an \$800 million stake in the company.

**J&J** was similarly spurred by the disclosure that billionaire investor Warren Buffett has added to his holdings in the health care giant.

At the same time, Buffett and Carl Icahn combined to perk up the rail sector after regulatory filings detailed their interests in transporters like  ${f CSX}$ .

**York Stock Exchange**, with advancers beating decliners by a 3-to-2 margin. Volume on the Nasdaq reached 2.11 billion shares, and winners outpaced losers 9 to 7.

Earlier, traders received mixed news on the housing front. The government said **U.S. home starts** jumped a greater-than-expected 2.5% in April to 1.53 million annualized units. On average, economists expected new construction to total 1.48 million units.

The report wasn't completely free of bad news, though. **Building permits** tumbled 8.9% to 1.42 million last month, well below the expected 1.52 million annual pace.

Also on the economic docket, the **Federal Reserve** said that industrial production rose 0.7% last month, above estimates for a 0.3% rise. Capacity utilization rose to 81.6%, compared with forecasts of 81.5%.

Following the previous close, one of the key names in semiconductor group, gearmaker **Applied Materials**, posted second-quarter profits and revenue that topped analysts' expectations. Still, Applied Materials lost 61 cents, or 3.1%, to end at \$19.17.

Shares of **Dell** ended higher even after news that the New York attorney general is suing the company over its sales practices. The PC maker's stock rose \$1.25, or 5.1%, to close at \$25.92.

Energy prices were mixed in the wake of the Energy Department's weekly inventory report, which showed a rise of 1 million barrels in crude inventories. Gasoline stocks added 1.7 barrels, and distillate stocks jumped 1 million barrels.

The front-month **June** oil contract fell by 62 cents to **\$62.55** a barrel, while gasoline ended higher by 3.5 cents at \$2.33 a gallon.

Metals prices tumbled. **Gold** lost \$13 to end the day at **\$662.50** an ounce, and silver shed 38 cents at \$12.93 an ounce.
