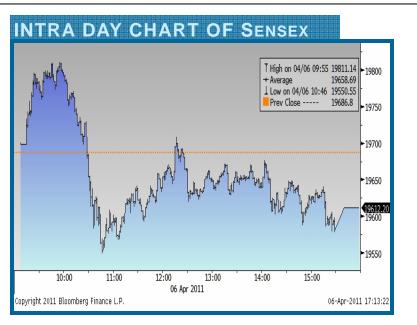

Indian stock market opened in green following the positive global cues and continued to trade higher. However, it pared gains in mid morning trade. A sudden slide pulled the market into the negative zone. There was small bout of profit booking after the rally in previous few sessions. Market came off lows and regained the positive zone in early afternoon trade. It slipped into the red once again in the second half of trade and ended the choppy session with moderate losses.

Nifty closed at 5,891.75, down by 18.30 points or 0.31 percent over the previous day closing of 5,910.05, after witnessing a low of 5,868.80 and a high of 5,944.45. Sensex closed at 19,612.20, down by 74.62 points or 0.38 percent over the previous day closing of 19,686.82. It touched an intraday low of 19,550.55 and high of 19,811.14.

The markets' breadth was positive. Out of 3,041 stocks traded, 1,765 stocks advanced, 1,165 stocks declined and 111 stocks remained unchanged. In Sensex, 10 stocks advanced and 20 stocks declined.

Among the sectors, BSE Teck, BSE IT and BSE Bankex were the main losers of the day, which declined by 0.84 percent, 0.69 percent and 0.43 percent respectively

In BSE Teck sector, Idea Cellular, Wipro and Tulip Telecom declined by 5.05 percent, 2.93 percent and 2.73 percent respectively. In BSE IT sector, TCS, Financial Tech and Mphasis declined by 1.25 percent, 0.87 percent and 0.66 percent respectively. In BSE Bankex sector, Union Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank and Bank of India declined by 1.99 percent, 1.12 percent and 1.10 percent respectively.

OUTLOOK

Indian stock market may continue to move range bound, albeit some volatility cannot be ruled out. We expect Nifty to move between 5850-5950 levels. Japan, Eurozone and the U.K. interest rate decisions will be in focus. Buy chemical related stocks like Tata Chemical, DCW for 6-8 percent gains in in the short term Buy Sesa Goa, Tata Motors and IFCI in dips.

NEWS



- ♦ NTPC posted a 24.17 percent rise in profit after tax (provisional and unaudited) during the quarter ended March 2011 to INR25.05 billion as compared to INR20.18 billion (unaudited) for the same period last year. It reported net sales of INR144.88 billion (provisional and un-audited) in Q4 of FY2010-11 as against INR123.05 billion (unaudited) in Q4 of FY2009-10, registering an increase of 17.74 percent. For FY2010-11, provisional and un-audited net sales was at INR537.21 billion as against INR461.69 billion (audited) during FY2009-10, registering an increase of 16.36 percent. Meanwhile, provisional and un-audited profit after tax for the year FY2010-11 stood at INR88.26 billion as compared to INR87.28 billion (audited) during FY2009-10, witnessing an increase of 1.12 percent. Interim dividend of 30 percent amounting to INR24.74 billion was paid during the year. It incurred capital expenditure of INR128.18 billion during FY2010-11, an increase of 22.46 percent over the last year's figure of INR104.67 billion.
- Sesa Goa received clearance from Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to send letters of offer to shareholders of Cairn India and proceed with the open offer of up to 20 percent of the shares of Cairn India. Sesa Goa will launch the open offer by April 11, 2011 at a price of INR355 a share for Cairn India. The acquisition of 51 percent of Cairn India by the Vedanta Group remains conditional on receipt of Government of India's approvals.
- Satyam Computer Services and five PricewaterhouseCoopers International affiliates have agreed to pay USD17.5 million to settle claims brought by U.S. regulators over an alleged USD1 billion accounting fraud. Satyam has agreed to pay a penalty of USD10 million.
- A consortium comprising Tata Power and SN Power Norway bagged the 'Dugar Hydro Electric Project' in Chenab Valley in Himachal Pradesh. The capacity for Dugar Hydro Electric Project is estimated to be approximately 236 MW. The 'Dugar Hydro Electric Project' will be developed through a Special Purpose Vehicle being formed and owned by the consortium.
- Supreme Infrastructure bagged four projects worth INR389.15 crores in building construction vertical in Mumbai.
- Elecon Engineering bagged order of INR1.76 billion from NMDC for the Down Hill Conveyor System for Kumaras-wamy Iron Ore Project, Package II. The order work includes design, engineering, manufacturing, supplying, erection, testing, commissioning as per technical specification including associated civil and structural works, electrical instrumentation, material handling equipments and other.
- Vantec Corporation, Japan signed a deal with Four Soft to use the company's integrated solution to automate management of its warehousing facilities.
- Godawari Power and Ispat's subsidiary, Hira Ferro Alloys, will buy 8.5 MW bio-mass power plant in Chhattisgarh on slump sale basis. The company entered into a definitive agreement with the owner of the power plant.
- Diamond Power Infrastructure entered into memorandum of understanding to acquire strategic stake in Utkal Galvanizers from promoters. The outstanding order book position of Utkal is about INR300 crores.
- DQ Entertainment signed co-production agreement with France based Method Animation for a new 3D HD series 'Robin Hood Mischief in Sherwood.' The production will comprise 52 episodes of 11 minutes each.
- Jyothy Laboratories emerged as the sole bidder for acquiring a majority stake in Henkel India from its German parent, as the bidding process closed on Tuesday.
- Lupin has filed a second suit in the U.S. against Ranbaxy Laboratories to prevent it from launching fenofibrate, a generic version of Lupin's cholesterol lowering drug Antara in the U.S.





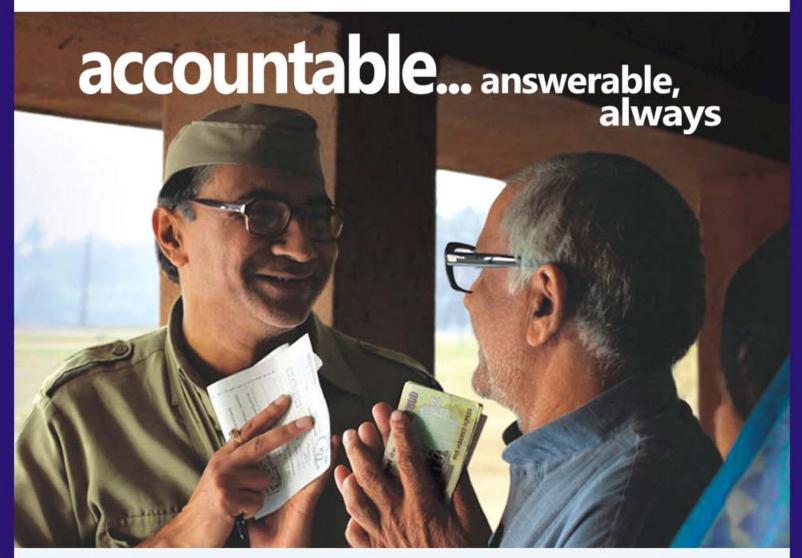
