Following the derivative expiry, Open interest decreased by Rs 20510 Cr or 33% at Rs 42,170 Cr. Open interest in number of shares went down by 25% from 142.97 Cr to 107.28 Cr shares. Open interest in futures, calls and puts changed by -19%, -68% and -55% respectively in value terms and -13%, -82% and -74% respectively in number of shares.

IV of Feb Nifty 4100 Call & 4000 Put was 27.9% & 29.6% respectively. Previous day IVS were 25.8% & 31.20% respectively for near strike options.

THE INDICATOR**Across the Atlantic**

The Dow Jones industrial average fell 52.39, or 0.41 percent, to 12,686.02. Broader stock indicators were mixed. The Standard & Poor's 500 index was down 1.25, or 0.09 percent, at 1,456.38. The Nasdaq rose 6.52, or 0.26 percent, to 2,524.94; the tech-dominated index is at a six-year high and finished past the 2,524.31 half-way mark of its all-time high of 5,048.62 set on March 10, 2000

Trading volume was \$1.4 billion on the New York Stock Exchange and 2.0 billion on the Nasdaq. Declining issues outpaced gainers by 17 to 14 on the NYSE, while rising stocks outpaced decliners 16 to 13 on the Nasdaq.

The market received an early lift from the tech sector and bulls chose that sector for a late afternoon comeback.

Investors were uneasy after a U.N. official said Iran did not agree to Security Council demands to suspend its nuclear ambitions. Also hurting stocks was a U.S. government report that showed a larger-than-expected drop in gasoline and heating oil inventories, causing crude prices to bound above \$60 a barrel.

Analog Devices Inc., which gave an optimistic outlook about improving business conditions, drove chip stocks. Investors were also encouraged about takeover activity this year as Whole Foods Market Inc. said it will buy rival Wild Oats Markets Inc. in a \$565 million deal.

Treasury prices slipped, raising the yield on the benchmark 10-year note to 4.73 percent from 4.68 percent late Tuesday. Treasury prices and yields move in opposite directions. In currency trading, the dollar gained versus the euro and the yen.

U.S. light crude oil for April delivery rose 88 cents to settle at \$60.95 a barrel on the New York Mercantile Exchange after the weekly oil inventories report showed a large drop in gasoline and oil inventories. COMEX gold for April delivery fell \$1 to settle at \$683 an ounce.
